

CONTACT RE-ESTABLISHED ! - Part 4, Meeting with Mr C.

Following on the letters from Mr C. printed in Journals 7 to 9, a meeting was arranged in Warminster and two communication experiments were set to try to duplicate the link with 'Lenston' <The man who called Earth Cantel>. These were done in the presence of the Editor (Peter), Jane, Mr K (a friend of Mr C) and also on the first occasion a number of other witnesses present at Fountain Centre.

Both experiments were successful, however the results did not involve the appearance of 'Lenston' in the room as on previous occasions with C. The first experiment resulted in Mr C. seeing 'Lenston' in his mind, an attempt to talk to him however failed, but Mr K started to pick up the very weak 'voice' and a limited conversation ensued, with Peter and others present asking questions. Some of these were unanswered and some Mr K seemed to have difficulty translating the 'idea' into english, due partly to the speed at which the answer came. Questions on delicate matters were left unanswered and one felt that a very strict code of conduct on what was discussed and not discussed was being enforced by the other end of the link. On this occasion there seemed an absolute veto on information regarding the origin or location of the communication. Questions were also asked by the other end of the link, specifically on the capacity of the human culture to deliver a nuclear weapon outside of the sphere of the Earth. Supplemental questions included the half lives of the fall out products. The voice seemed more interested in acquiring information than giving it, however a friendly diplomatic atmosphere ensued with detante type manners being observed by both ends of the link. While this was transpiring Mr C was experiencing a 3D colour 'vision' of the Earth as might be observed from an object in orbit some considerable distance out from the Earth but not nearly as far as the Moon (by ref. to NASA photos from Apollo missions). In discussion afterwards the girl sitting next to Mr C stated that at the same time she also had been seeing this 'vision'. As this witness is I6 and something of a sceptic, this was her first visit to Fountain Centre, this corroboration is interesting and obviously not prearranged. It was almost as if the 'beam' of the communication was not fine enough only corocus on Mr C, but also took in the girl and she saw the same picture.

The second experiment was more successful. Caution was still the watchword with 'Lenston' however the experiment continued P 4.

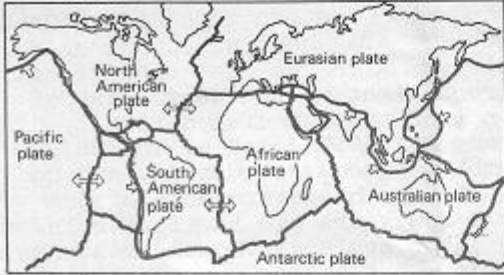

lasted much longer. This time 'Lenston' opened up a bit more but still a diplomatic rebuke came on some stock questions. The communication was again via Mr K, Mr C only having vision why this split of the communication media between two people was a point of interest. It was almost like when tuning a TV when you can lose the picture but keep the sound or vice versa. Peter asked questions and advice on a number of issues. 'Lenston' stated that they had formerly made contact with one other person in Warminster (this person was named, but for diplomatic reasons its omission from this article is required and it was stated that this communication had proved unsatisfactory. During this communication Mr K had the impression that 'Lenston' was talking from somewhere very deep underground but questioning by Peter as to location met with a no comment on all occasions. 'Lenston' did let slip however that he was physically here, on Earth at the moment. Certainly his description, see Journal No 7, shows him kitted out more for terrestrial living than floating around outer space. An apology came on the matter of a number of accidents involving a motorist hitting some members of his team some years ago while they were walking near Warminster. When the drivers stopped and returned to the injured people, they had disappeared. 'Lenston' explained that they could teleport over short distances, and were several fields away when the car drivers were looking for them on the road. He stated that the team which numbered ten in all, of which he was not the leader, had been inexperienced in automobiles and their travel and did not realise that they could not stop or avoid them. He made no comment on how many people were involved in this incident, but one gathered the team had not been badly hurt.

When questioned as to their prime concern at the moment with regard to potential dangers on the Earth 'Lenston' was far more specific and detailed in his information than on matters regarding themselves. The answers were unexpected. He had two main concerns at the top of the list.

One: The San Andreas Fault in California. 'Lenston' made it clear that he knew the Earth very well, was widely traveled and experienced in earthly matters. The San Andreas which lies to the eastern edge of the Central Pacific plate where it connects to the North American plate is a fault line caused by the two plates sliding against one another. Due to

the immense friction of the two plates pressing against each other they do not move smoothly, be it only measured in inches per year, but jam together and then jump every so often when the pressure becomes too great. The last time the San Andreas jumped it

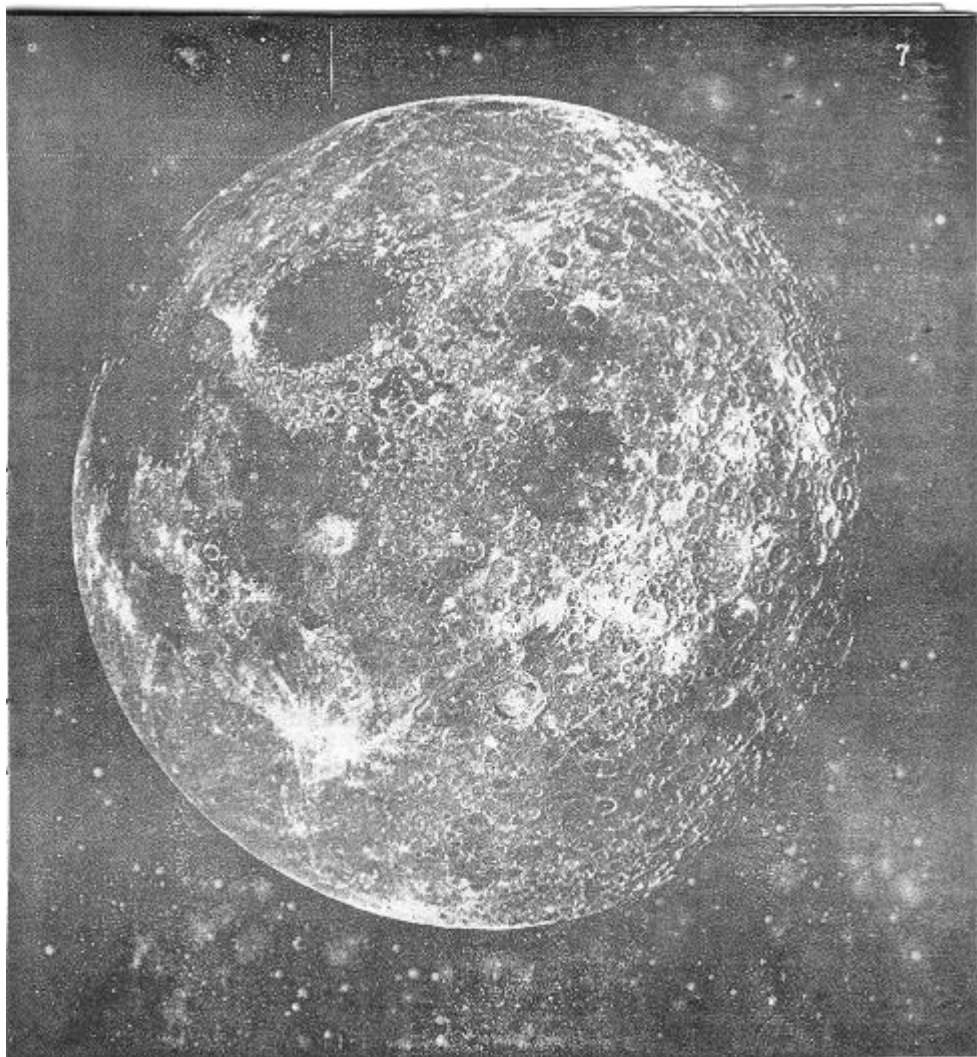
caused the great San Francisco earthquake. The San Andreas which runs roughly north/south through California has been the cause of a considerable amount of concern and research over the past few years by the US authorities as it is calculated to be long overdue for a major, for a major leap, some think of 14ft or more, the shock waves from which would bring down a high percentage of buildings and structures in that area. The concern over the problem was the inspiration for the film 'Earthquake' which some might have seen.

According to 'Lenston' the San Andreas is now highly unstable and a major cause for concern. He volunteered the information that it was connected to the (as we wrote it at the time) 'Mariner Trench'. Subsequent research would make it seem likely that we made a slight phonetic error and the name was actually the 'Mariana Trench'. The Mariana Trench, estimated by some scientist to be the deepest bit of ocean in the world, lies just off the US Mariana Islands in the West Pacific between New Guinea and Japan. It lies at the Western Edge of the Central Pacific Plate where the plate is in collision with a sub-division of the Australian Plate and the Eurasian Plate centred on the Philippine Islands. The indication by 'Lenston' was that seismic activity in the Mariana Trench, or registered in the Mariana Islands, or even near by, was a direct RED ALERT that the San Andreas was about to jump. The feeling was that the condition just for the moment was one of AMBER ALERT for these places (taken on a scale of Amber = Warning, Red = Serious Warning and Black = time you were somewhere else in a hurry. It is always taken as read that if an Amber alert applies, there is no guarantee that the situation may move so suddenly towards the black that no further warning can be given. Just depends if you are lucky. All of this is bad news for the West Coast of California, something of an industrial centre for the US strategic armaments production. Its no consolation either for

Japan which lies just to the north western edge of the Central Pacific Plate where earthquakes are about as common as No 9 buses up Kensington High Street. Also the eastern edge of the Central Pacific Plate runs right up the West coast of Oregon, State of Washington (not to be confused with Washington DC which is on the Atlantic coast of the US), through along British Columbia <Vancouver> Canada, and up into US Alaska. It was at this north eastern edge of the Central Pacific Plate that a few years ago the faults let rip and produced the highest Richter scale earthquake readings in recorded history. So large was the Alaska quake that mountains change altitude. Fortunately being a very under populated area loss of life was minimal and although the town of Anchorage suffered damage this would in no way be related to the havoc caused in California, one of the most bustling states of the USA.

Britains take heart though. Even if the Central Pacific Plate is the largest in area of the pieces of crust that make up this cracked world, and it is true that a small shift in, would naturally produce balancing movement in the other plates some time in the future, effects in these distant British Isles are likely to be totally minimal.

Having gone deeply into this number one item of concern, about which I may add Mr C and Mr K had little personal knowledge, 'Lenston' mentioned his number two listing; this was Biological Warfare. It was not entirely certain from the questions and answers whether this was in isolation or as connected to the number one earthquake problem. It is interesting however that the very next day our copy of 'Plain Truth' magazine, one of very many diverse publications taken by Fountain Centre, arrived and in it was an article on the 'new biology' pointing out the new hazards from this research. The new developments which are causing concern according to the article are the capacity to interfere with DNA by transplantation of chromosomes and genes. If I might quote from the excellent piece of research done by 'Plain Truth' <even if we don't go along with the bible bashing evangelism of the mag> : To quote from Dr. Liebe F Cavalieri, professor of biochemistry at Cornell University, "A single unrecognized accident could contaminate the entire earth with an ineradicable and dangerous agent that might not reveal its presence until its deadly work was done ... It is possible, intentionally or unintentionally, to construct highly dangerous agents of other types, worse than anything yet envisioned in biological warfare." Harvard biologist Dr. Ruth Hubbard
