

bomb." "It could unleash 'super-bacteria' that are resistant to drugs and spread new types of disease world wide." Dr. Robert Sinsheimer, chairman of the Biology Division of the California Institute of Technology, warns that the new genetics may well be irreversible. "Because of human fallibility, these new organisms are almost certain to escape," Sinsheimer says in the article. "There's no way to recapture them, and thus we have the great potential for a major calamity."

With such a comment from Cal.Tech. perhaps the concern of 'Lenston' was compounded by the risk of an escape of such super bugs in the event of the chaos caused by a major quake affecting California. It is known that quite a lot of government facilities lie near the San Andreas Fault. Indeed some schools, hospitals even nuclear power stations are built nearly over it. We can but HIGHLY RECOMMEND that the whole range of provisions for facilities at risk in this area be reviewed, up-dated and made to take into account the possibility of a major quake in the hours of darkness when virulent experimental organisms could escape from the biological shell in which they are supposed to remain, and infect the area.

When questioned about the general nuclear warfare and fall out problem, either by accident or intent, 'Lenston' seemed surprisingly unprejudiced. The impression given was that the whole thing was in hand and taken care of. As I am familiar with a number of reports of various forms of intentional malfunction which have been observed in connection with ufos, it would seem that the chances of a major nuclear accident have been covered to the extent that a situation affecting the biosphere would and easily could be stopped. It can be no small pill to swallow for the two great powers that the defence systems on which they spend over 38% of their gross national product, and in which they place so much faith, if it really came to it, just would cease to function - as effective as a motor car with no battery. It is food for thought that what the world spends in one day on arms would support UNICEF's [United Nations Children's Fund] work for ten years!

A number of other issues were discussed, including the Fountain Journal. Of this 'Lenston' was of the opinion that it was, "crude but effective." He went on to say that it was not powerful enough and in the context in which it was said we took it to mean that it was not reaching the right people, enough people, or saying the things that needed to be said. More ufo Interest in Empty Buildings ? - Ed Harris

Try and imagine if you can what it's like to be in an empty house on a wet wintry evening and to suddenly struck blind by an unknown force! I can assure you that the experience is one that you ar'nt likely to want repeated, even, as in this case, the blindness only lasted some five minutes. Let me explain.

We'd received a phone call from a Mr Bennet that he thought his house, which was in the process of being renovated and extended, and had one section of its attic wall missing at the time, covered by a huge tarpaulin, was haunted, and could we go and have a look! It appeared that the house had'nt been lived in for some six months while the work was in progress, as the owner lived nearby in another property. On a number of occasions people had informed him that they had seen lights and heard noises coming from the house in question. After a thorough search of the building he found no trace of anyone, all the doors and windows had been securly fastened and showed no signs of having been forced.

However! A few days later, while looking round his garden last thing at night, he himself heard a noise. A sort of bumping, dragging noise, like something soft and heavy being dragged down stairs! He immediately let himself into the house and stood listening for a few minutes before going on. The noise still reached him, from above, so moving carefully in the dark, as the electricity had been switched off at the onset of the building work, he made his way up the stairs.

As he creeped the way up the stairway the noise became clearer, he now described it as a low humming with a slight

throb breaking the tone at intervals of about five seconds! By now he was on the landing but was unable to determine from which direction the noise was coming as it now seemed to be all around him.

Then! At once the noise ceased and he was left with a ringing in his ears which continued for a few minutes. Eventually, as he decided on his next move, a scraping sound reached him from the attic above. He at once made for the room where the steps were kept and succeeded in setting them up under the trap door. Apprehensive now, as he debated whether or not to fetch help first in case he was attacked, the humming started up again, this time reaching a much higher pitch which set his teeth on edge, though still quite in volume, he decided to investigate on his own as whatever it was had now set up a strong vibration. As soon as he lifted the trap door the noise intensified tremendously and a peculiar smell reached his nostrils like that of burning rubber, but more sickening. Then, as he looked about him, still standing on the steps, he made out a faint silver shape at the far end, near where the hole in the wall was! Unable to recognise what it was he climbed up into the attic, but as he did so, a luminous glow came from the shape! Then, without warning a beam of light, shot at him and he was unable to see anything more! He remembers falling down amongst the rafters and lying there. Crying by now in panic as all he could see were flashing lights before his eyes, and also, he was unable to rise from his face down position, a force seemed to be holding him there!

After a while he calmed down and was able to get into a sitting position, though when he held his watch up to his face he was unable to see its luminous dial! He concluded that he must have remained there for the best part of twenty minutes, this was later reduced to no more than five minutes by comparing times etc. In this time he realised that the noise had ceased and all was quiet again, and as he sat there he found that he could make out the night sky, and looking at his watch again, he found that he could see!

He hastily scrambled out of the attic and rushed outside, still a little unsteady on his feet. Outside, he looked at the house, the heavy tarpaulin covering the wall had disappeared, presumably blown away by the wind! Mr Bennet didn't inform anyone of what had happened to him, as he wasn't sure in his own mind of what he had witnessed. It wasn't until six weeks later that he contacted me, and only then because he had heard that the house was supposed to be haunted and wanted it cleared up discreetly as one or two neighbour

I4 - also seen something bright seemingly shoot from the house at the time Mr Bennet was in the attic!

Well! We didn't find any ghost, but what we did find left many questions still unanswered for us! Why was there in the attic a huge magnetic disturbance, while the rest of the house was normal? Why had Mr Bennet's watch stopped suddenly in the attic? Why were the straining and retaining ropes which held the tarpaulin in place completely snapped off? If the wind had broken them surely they wouldn't have all gone at once! But the thing which I found most baffling centered around the tarpaulin itself, for when we recovered it we found that our compasses were affected by it, it had been magnetised! Also, when it was recovered some 600 yds away, why was it UPWIND from the house?

After extensive checking and rechecking of the various facts regarding the direction and speed of the wind, the only conclusion which we could draw was that it had been carried there by some solid bodied object! Was this yet another case of a UFO sighting, admittedly this time with a difference, perhaps we shall never know. Yet with all the evidence before me I find it hard to come to any other answer!
