over are very bright, as bright as Venus or the Echo type satellite. They also quite often transit in a level path rather than a curve. This direction has no relation to the direction of the wind and they often switch on or off before they reach any occulting obstructions such as clouds or hills or ground haze. Some nights one can go out and see, given a clear sky, a few satellites pass over. Other nights the numbers seem quite out of proportion. I have hed watchers come back after a three hour watch and declare they have seen no UFO's but recorded 38 satellites, all of them nearly overhead?

Some people watching come armed with 'UFO detectors', a primitive device using a compass needle to detect magnetic variation. On the IOth July 1976 a report from Robert Norman and Kevin Goodman gave some indication that they may work. At II.29pm two detectors that were sited at Cradle Hill, away from cars and watchers and protected from the wind, went off together for no apparent reason. Some 15 seconds later a ufo was seen going over. It pulsated and then went out, flashed once brightly as if in farewell and was not seen again.

Since the commencement of Fountain Journal I have been receiving letters daily from people who have seen UFO's, pilots, engineers, vicars among them. Three or more a week come in from the Warminster area, and thats after I've written off space junk, meteors and such like. I don't ask you to believe it, go out and look for them, then you can judge for yourself!

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WHY WARMINSTER?

Is this the centre of some powerful magnetic energy, necessary for re-charging an advanced form of propulsion? The Wessex area of Britain has the largest concentration of burial grounds going back nearly four thousand years. I believe the shape of the Bronze Age graves, being perfectly circular, was intended as being representational of the Sun, or UFO's, or perhaps both.

I believe that the celebrated white Horses of the Wessex Downs were carved on the hillsides for the purpose of guiding-in UFO pilots. They were intentional landmarks. All these are hypotheses, true; yet did not certain tribes of Papua and New Guinca worship the 'silver bird'-our modern aerorlane-ind set up stylised models of them?

That inveterate compiler of freekish oddities that seem wholly disconnected from natural phenomena, Charles Fort, said of the worldwide incursions of UFOs: "I think we are property. I say we belong to something. That once upon a time this Earth was a no-mans land: that other worlds explored and colonised here and fought among themselves for possession. But now it is owned by something - and that something owns this Earth and all others have been warned off."

He is not the sole shrewd chronicler and investigator of unknown incoming intelligences to conclude that the aliens are so at variance with anything we know that to try and describe them in language everyone understands is an impossible task In essence, our owners, creators (and genetic controllers?) in the cosmos are not merely from another world but another type of universe, their laws of chemistry and physics foreign to ours. The weird corollary is that they can actually appear in physical form when they wish - and in this atomic and molecular cell-changing manner have been resposible for nearly all legends of heavenly angels and great white gods from the ski which have originated from various countries and been scorned in these so-called more enlightened times. Looking at certain UFO testimony and flight patterns in retrospect, some deep thinkers say Ufonauts are totally uninhibited by physical limitations such as bodies......

It is reassuring to us at Warminster to have many corroborative and confirming sightings from other sectors of our globe, that largely exonerate us from cruel jibesa and cynicism we constantly encounter from the know-alls and experts. Testimony from people like Byyce Bond, a journalist, radio announcer and teacher of para-psychology in New York, for instance. He came to Warminster in August of 1972 and has written and broadcast the following experience in his words:

"August 26th I972. Warminster at this time of night, eve for a Saturday, was somewhat deserted. Only a few people ambled along the narrow streets. I felt that I had eyes on me all the wa It was a most unusual feeling.

The small narrow streets, with high brick walls, sky overcast, town strangely quiet - maybe a prelude to what I was about to experience on that eventful night! After walking a short distance through narrow archways and flowerlined paths, I was amazed how lovely it smelled and how clead it was... On the hill, some of the skywatching group had their telescopes set up on tripods, others had binoculars and cameras ready. The thing that really struck me was how friendly everyone was. A good portion are very curious, another percentage are thrill-seekers, and the remainder? Well, they just enjoyed being there with this warm, loving group of spiritual individuals, sharing stories and conversation.

UFO's have been here for eons of years. History is filled with reports of strange flowing craft, of landings and contactees. But due to negative programming of these ancients, and fear of the unknown being magnified out of all proportion from mouth to mouth, it spread right into modern times. Only in these times we blame television and motion pictures for doing the damage: creating near mass-panic in the mind, showing these UFO's as hostile, coming down from the heavens to devour, murder and rape - and to gobble us up!

This travesty, of beings who are thousands or even millions of years ahead of us in technology, intelligence and spiritual intent! What the masses do not understand, they fear.



We drove over to Starr Hill, another ancient burial mound area. This sector is where the Romans built upon, with a few of the remnants still in evidence. The location was down in a valley, wheat figlds all around and high hills and ridges. The sky started to clear, filled with thousands of beautiful stars and still no UFO's.It was getting awfully late and still I had not interviewed Arthur Shuttlewood. My voice was getting weaker, my head clogged up due to the cool dampness. I got his attention and we crawled into one of the nearby cars to keep warm while I interviewed him for American radio listeners.

He was telling me that, only a few nights ago, three large entities about eight feet in height were seen down in a little hollow, to which he pointed. While in their presence, people felt a great warmth exuded from them, they were engulfed by it and the scent of roses and violets was very strong ... All of a sudden, while Arthur was speaking, his conversation went to a peculiar light that just appeared in the field in front of us. He was somewhat blase about the whole thing. Arthur then said ouietly: "I'm very glad you are here tonight, Bryce. There in front of us is a UFO. Notice the triangle shape and the coloured

lights going around? That is a very good sign."

It then started to lift in a weird pattern - then just disappeared! I was flabbergasted, for it was so close While describing that one on tape for American listeners, another one popped up about 25 degrees along the horizon. This one was very brilliant white, while the other was a blaze of coloured lights. The intensity increased as it raised itself very slowly, did a little dance in the sky, then took off and disappeared. But, before it did, Arthur jumped from the car, borrowed a flashligh t and sent Morse code to it. It in turn sent back the same signal that Arthur flashed out. Then it flew off. This was the highlight of my British trip: a close sighting: yet I honestly felt spiritually close to the lights in the field."

Bryce began interviewing other watchers as to what they had witnessed. "I turned off the recorder and made a mad dash inac the field, went into a light trance state and asked higher intelligence to please make contact again. Leaving the group, I made my way down to the hollow, where two nights before, three entities were seen. Again I went into a light trance state for what seemed to be a few minutes only

I was wakened by my friends, who thought I had gone. I must have been there for about an hour. I truely do not know what transpired while I was there or in trance. I told my friends I would return shortly and they went back to where the others were standing near the farm barn. I then made my way slowly back to the parked cars and people. Now here is a strange thing: The wheat in the field next to me as I walked back up the dirt road was about waist high

I walked along the road very close to the fence. Suddenly I heard a noise - like something crushing the wheat down. There was no breeze blowing that night. I looked over. The moon had just come out, shining very brightly; and there, before my eyes, a large depression was being formed in the growing corn. The wheat was being crushed down in a counter-clockwise position. I t too was shaped like a triangle and measured about 20 feet from point to point.

I stood there a few moments and experienced a tremendous tingling sensation: the same sweet smell: being engulfed by warm air ... Not fully understanding what had happened, I walked up the road to get Arthur, my host. Speaking of the field, Arthur

rointed out some landing impressions in the section fronting the barn. A circle 30 feet in circumference, with another depression spotted, but this one a long cigar shape. All the depressions, recently made and noticed, were in a counter clockwise fashion.

"After all this, I was very happy and thankful. My mission had been a success," confided Bryce, who is research editor of 'Beyond Reality; a leading US psychic and metaphysical magazine, and also well known interviewer in the States.

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Kon-Tiki Sighting

Not many Britons know that Thor Heyerdahl, of Kon-Tiki fame, who crossed the Atlantic from east to west in a replica of an ancient Egyptian papyrus boat called Ra II, was among hundreds who witnessed a UFO reported from a number of Caribbean localities on Monday, July 29th 1970. The story was given no prominence in the English press, yet it was the subject of a lengthy item in the Morwegian 'Morgenposten' of August Ist. It was an occurrence of some importance, obviously, so merited headlines given. The story ran as follows: "San Juan (NTB-UPI):- Thor Heyerdahl and his crew on board RA 2, the crew aboard the United Nations oceanographical ship Calmara, and thousands of citizens at St. Thomas, St. Croix and other Caribbean Islands, reported on Monday night at 02.45 that they had observed an unidentified flying object.

The first report came from a navigator on board RA 2, Norman Baker, who said that he had charge of the steering of the vessa; when he caught sight of the 'thing' which was round, flat and clearly lighted. He cried out to Heyerdahl and the Mexican anthropologist, Dr. Santiago Genoves, who was with them. All three looked at the Thing for ten minutes. Also Calmara, which was on course towards RA 2, reported that they had seen the object. Newspapers and radio stations on several Caribbean Islands reported that they received hundreds of telephone calls from people who had observed the Thing, also many fishermen out on the sea."

"And this command I give You - that you love one another." Thus spoke the Christ unto his followers. And thus came into the world the greatest command that has ever been given -- the law of harmony.








Abobe. The Interstellar Ship....

I am writing of 26th-27th June 1976 sighting at Warminster, I will not list the sightings we all saw from II.16pm to I.10am at Starr Hill that night as you know as well as I what we all saw, I hope you remember me I was talking to you most of the night with my friend Steve Evans. Wel

just after you departed Steve and myself went back to Cradle Hill where I joined a few other people sky watching. Our first sighting was at I. IOam which was a brilliant white light which shot straigh down from the sky over the copse area.

We were all talking about the light we had just seen when someone flashed their torch over the field towards the golf club house. Then a great crackling sound came straight at us! We all jumped back! The sound came to where I was standing and then swung round to the rear of the party, the sheep in the next field went mad. There was no visable thing to be seen.

In the morning I saw the grass was flattened in a funny way. I have enclosed a picture of this taken with my Polaloid Land camera Swinger II, (above).

Witnesses present were, Steve Evans, myself, T & B Chivers P Pegler, Peter and Paul Humpherys, all from Welksham. At I.30am a very bright light crossed the sky over Cradle. At I.40am a loud clicking sound to the right of the copse. I. 50am, white light zig-zagged from south to north above Cradle. 2.20am white light zig-zagged and circled south of Cradle, disappeared at 2.22am. 2.55am white light zig-zagged south to west. 3.20am white light crossed west to east, all present saw these unusual lights. When the other people departed early in the morning, Steve and I went to Heavens Gate, it was very bright, no other people were about, when I heard heavy footsteps in the bushes which are very thick for people or animals to walk through. The footsteps were very heavy and loud - they were coming in our direction. I called out, and the footsteps storred, then came harder and louder. I called out,"Whos that!" and the footsteps came on still, then they spooped We stood there for about ten minutes but nothing else happened.
