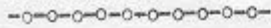

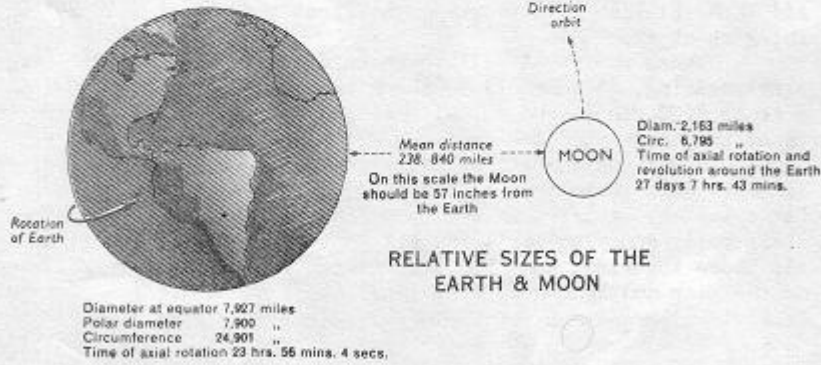
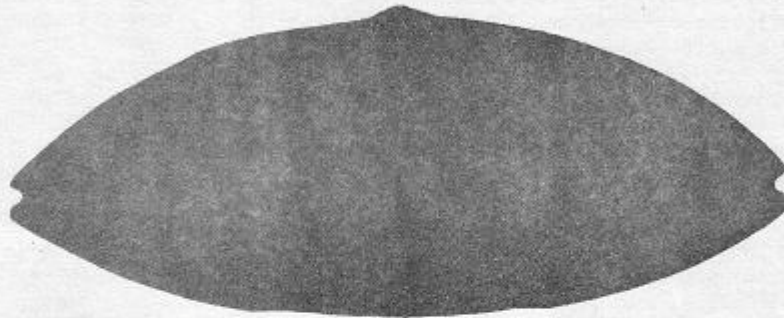
Meanwhile back at the plot: What do we intend to do with Fountain Centre? More than just a meeting place, more than a building, more than just a magazine.

For about five minutes on Friday, three adults and at least 90 children at Treleigh CP School, Redruth, watched a spherical object cross high in the midday sky ... and what exactly it was is a complete mystery to them. Most of them - they watched from the school yard - agreed that it resembled two dinner plates face to face. "It was white and spinning", said Miss Deborah Foster, a teacher. "It appeared to be very high up, and came from the Truro direction. We lost sight of it over Carn Brea. It was saucer-shaped and seemed to have an aura or 'halo'".

Another teacher, Mr Sam Hawkins, said he clearly saw silver and yellow flashes at 90 degrees to the object's direction. He said it was travelling very slowly. "It went through high cloud, yet we could still see it," he added. Mrs Sylvia Harris, school secretary agreed it was round and whitish. She also saw flashes from it. "They were like lightning and were spasmodic," she said. "I have never seen anything like it before." Miss Foster added: "It was a little frightening. I do not like anything I cannot explain." Pupils said there was no sound, and the sphere changed to green hue when it went behind high clouds. They agreed it was spinning and saw flashes from it. They were certain it bore no markings.

Mr Sidney Thorne, headmaster - who is interested in UFOs - missed the sighting. He said it could not have been a weather balloon, as the object's journey included a distinct manoeuvre. He added that unexplained objects had been sighted at the school and by parents at North-country, Redruth, in March and November, 1973.

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Book Review: OUR MYSTERIOUS SPACESHIP MOON - is our nearest neighbour in space a huge alien spacecraft? by Don Wilson. Published 1976 by Sphere Books Ltd, 30/32 Gray's Inn Road, London WC1X 8JL. Paperback, 60p.

Why is the Moon only 60% the density of the Earth, why are some of the rocks brought back by the Apollo missions dated older even than the Solar System and why do they contain such high concentrations of metals with very high melting points, even metals that are not found naturally in nature. Together with UFO reports from the Moon missions, strange radio 'break through', and possible structures on the Moon the book examines, "the answers we don't even have questions for", that have baffled NASA scientist analysing the Apollo missions. What great truth is NASA keeping from the world or is it that they just don't know? Another piece for the jigsaw!

World War II was particularly rich in mysterious aerial phenomena -

and one of the grave dangers at present is that a mistaken impression of a UFO could be taken for a hostile earth force which might easily precipitate the start of another world-wide conflagration of bloodshed and terror.

This fearful possibility must be uppermost in the minds of governmental defence ministries and departments everywhere, if we accept that they know UFOs are real enough and not mere mental machinations of millions of witnesses now listed throughout our planet. And they do know, of course ...

A long while before the term Flying Saucer or UFO was coined, Polish soldier Antoni Szachnowski could testify to an incident that surprised and shocked both Allied and German troops engaged in action in Italy during the summer of 1944.

The battle raged around Loreto, Castelfodardo and Osimo. "About 10.30a.m., in an almost cloudless sky, there suddenly appeared an egg-shaped, metallicly glistening, motionless object," says Antoni now chairman of the Anglo-Polish Research Club in London.

"Our anti-aircraft guns immediately opened a barrage of fire. Shells burst below the object, and after a while our batteries stopped when we realised with astonishment that the German batteries were also shelling the same object. They continued to do so for some time, but eventually stopped.

"The object remained motionless for another minute or so. Then it tilted about 50 degrees and suddenly moved very speedily upwards disappearing in the blue Italian skies. At the time this was only a one-day wonder. Other emotions of the war pushed it to the back of my mind."

It kept there until discussions in the camp of the Polish Resettlement Corps in Norfolk, the war over, Germany defeated, yet Poland not free. Most of the Polish soldiers had to make the bitter decision to remain 'in exile'. Time spent in the camp in England gave opportunity for exchanging ideas in endless conversations.
