

Topics ranged over almost everything in the world, a fair share of time devoted to discussions about strange "Portean" phenomena which abound in times of war ... Antoni tells us:

"One evening I related the story of that sighting in Italy. Among others listening were some Polish airman. They were very interested, for they also had on two occasions some very strange 'escorts' in the air during bombing sorties over Germany.

"It transpired that many Allied airman had noticed mysterious aerial objects or lights during the war. They had even given a name to them, the Foo-Fighters, and thought they were some secret German weapon, and vice-versa, the Germans took them for some contraption of the Allies.

"This gave us food for thought. Then, in the summer of 1947, a new topic sprang into the news - Flying Saucers. We decided to investigate this phenomenon and keep in touch! Many of the wartime veterans did just that ... Antoni recalls a remarkable incident that occurred in Gydinia, Poland, several years ago, which raised as much controversy as that following in the wake of the October 1973 UFO 'flap' over six US states when two Mississippi fishermen were taken aboard a spacecraft.

In a lecture to the Isle of Wight UFO Investigation Society, Antoni detailed how an object had been seen to fall into the harbour at Gydinia one wintry day in January. Later, a man was found wandering along the sea-front in an extremely confused state. (Remember early Warminster happenings of this bizarre nature, related in 'The Warminster Mystery').

He was taken to a local medical clinic for observation and apparently he had an unusual number of fingers, whether more or less than normal is not clear, and he was dressed in a one-piece suit which defied all efforts to remove it by the hospital staff. Eventually it was removed with the aid of metal shears and found to consist of exceptionally tough material.

A bracelet on one of the stranger's wrist was removed, after which he died immediately. A post-mortem examination revealed significant differences in the arrangement both of his internal organs and his circulatory system, which was reported to follow a spiral path round his body.

Without warning, the hospital was suddenly sealed-off by Polish authorities who placed guards at the entrance. No one was allowed in or out of the bay where the body was lying. Some time afterwards a lorry arrived, complete with a refrigerated container, all heavily guarded. The lorry then left with its strange cargo and according to the report, the container was addressed to a research institute in Moscow.

The hospital returned to normal after this and Mr. Szachnowski thought it was little more than a nice sensational story with a thick science-fiction flavour. However, he later chanced to meet in London a fellow-Pole. This man, during conversation, revealed that he was on the staff of the Gydinia hospital and that all the details were correct. A S
