## That Old Familiar Feeling

Picture the scene if you can as I sit on my bed looking out of the open window at the late summer sky. Ursa Major was in full view, unchanged for thousands of years, and as I gazed at it I focused on Etz, following the imaginary pointer line to Arcturus. Arcturus the mighty star in the Bootes group called the Herdsman. This particular constellation holds much fascination for me as I remember studying the star messages emitting from the region of Epsilon (Izar) in the twenties.

It was one of those times when you begin to wonder at the credibility of it all, when, almost subconsciously, I became aware of a star shining to the left of my vision! I turned my attention towards it trying to pinpoint it in the star field, but to my amazement I found it to be moving across the Heavens!

My binoculars to hand I focused them on the faintly yellow object as it traversed Polaris, coming to rest a little below Cassiopea. Here it remained for something like ten minutes, long enough for me to view it through my three inch refractor. The sight I had took my breath away, and in my haste I almost knocked my telescope over! For there in my eyepiece sat a perfect example of a UFO! Circular, with raised roof, I watched fascinated as it seemed to revolve on its own axis, the yellow light turning to light orange in the process.

Increasing the magnification to x120 I found that it more than filled my field of view, the reason being that it was descending! I hurriedly forsook my three inch and rushed out, armed with the binoculars, just in time to see the strange craft hovering, no more than 200 metres above me.

So as to obtain a better view I lay on the grass with the optics to my eyes, and as I ranged over the now, intensely close, vehicle, my whole body seemed to relax, and a feeling of complete contentment passed over me, in fact I had to struggle to stay awake!

Was some force at work trying to lull me into a sense of unreality? - or was this how we (our race) are meant to be? Would we be in a better position to receive our extra-terrestrial hosts if all the bustle and greed of our modern civilisation were forsaken? I for one am beginning to wonder, for although having studied ufology and psychical phenomena for a good many years I was surprised, and unprepared, for that feeling of, (I call it) being at one with the Heavens, and it was with heart felt regret that I witnessed before



my eyes the complete disappearance of the craft some five minutes later.....

Air Chief reports "I saw a Flying Saucer" - 11th July 76.

This widely reported item appeared in the Sunday Express, but as many people appear not to have heard of it we reprint it as follows:

The latest report on a flying saucer sighting is very similar to hundreds of others lying in the files at the Spanish Air Ministry in Madrid.

But this one is not being tucked away and forgotten. For it is signed by one of Spain's top serving officers. General Carlos Cervero commanding officer of the Spanish Air Force in the Canary Islands, has reported seeing a UFO hovering above the village of Sabada in a remote part of eastern Spain.

Now his statement is expected to revive demands for the UFO files of many Governments to be opened to the public. The general was spending a few days near Sabada when he saw the saucer hovering overhead. "It was," he said, "giving off a brilliant light. And it travelled at an extraordinary speed." The object, he says, took just two seconds to cover 12 miles to the next village.

Said the general; "As an Air Force officer I hold, officially, the same opinions as the Air Ministry. But personally, I think these unidentified flying objects come from other planets."

The generals report was backed up the next day by well-known doctor Francisco Padron. "It was nearly dark," he said, "And I was driving along a lonely road. Then I saw a round sphere about 40ft. in diameter hovering above the road ahead of me."

"It was emitting a blueish light and about 20ft. above the ground. As I approached, my radio cut out but my headlights kept working. I passed right underneath and saw silhouetted inside through a type of porthole, two very tall figures dressed in bright red. Then it took off and vanished in the direction of Tenerife."

Another one from the Snowdon Skylane - B. Guiver writes:-

Mt. Snowdon, Wales, 12.55pm, 28/6/76. Weather: Sunny, very clear, hot, not much wind. The UFO: Long, rounded, solid, colour black.

While on holiday in North Wales on the 28/6/76 while driving with my wife & child down the A4086 from Llanrug to Cwm-Y-Glo we had Mt. Snowdon in view. It was while looking at Snowdon that I spotted a large black object in the sky. It was moving towards the peak of Snowdon, from the round mountain to the left of Snowdon Peak. I said, "Whats That? Its huge and shaped like a UFO or mother ship."

After seeing it for 10secs (still driving) a hill on the right blocked it from sight. It took us 15 seconds to get it back in view. I then parked the car on the corner to take a picture of it.

It was travelling back the way it had gone between Mt. Snowdon and the rounded Mt. on the left. Before I could take a photo it disappeared behind the rounded Mt.

Second sighting: 30/6/76. 3pm, Mt. Snowdon, weather as above, UFO: Round, colour black, primrose inside, silver outside.

Two days later whilst climbing up Snowdon and looking at birds in the sky (and anything, after the first sighting), I suddenly saw three objects flying in formation at about 2000ft above us. They were zig-zagging all over the place but still keeping in formation all the time at quiet a speed.

When the sun light hit one of the objects as it turned so I could see the bottom of one of the objects. I could see the outside was silver and the inside a primrose colour. It was just like a saucer in shape. I took a photo of them in the distance but it did not come out.

On the 16th of October 1976 at about 11'00 am, a Warminster youth and two of his friends were travelling in a small van towards Bath. They were just outside the city boundary when Steve noticed, looking out of the window, what he described as, "Two metallic looking spherical objects."

The velocity of the van was approx. 40 - 50 kilometres per hour. The objects were hovering over a small village in a valley, and so to the observers appeared to be about 3° elevation from the line of the road. The objects appeared to have no relative motion. Steve then called the attention of his two companions, who agreed that the objects could not be explained by natural or manmade objects.

The van then went round a bend and behind a bank of trees and so the objects disappeared from their sight. When they emerged from behind the trees they saw only one of the objects. From this they could not define whether it was one of the original objects, or if it was a quite separate object. This appeared to be at an elevation of about 5° higher than the original sighting. The van then went round another bend and by this time the objects had disappeared.

'Night Walker' near Star House. 25th-29th Oct. 1976

Kevin Goodman, Colin Rees, Chris Butler began a sky-watch at 8.00pm, 25th Oct. The conditions were cloudy with occasional patches of mist floating about. No ufo's were seen, as it remained cloudy.

On Tuesday, 26th, about 11.30am, Chris and Colin went to Cradle Hill copse, taking with them cameras, and a tape recorder. When inside the copse they switched on the tape recorder and continued to make records of the area. When arriving back at the Fountain Centre, they played back the tape. Recorded on the tape were a series of rapid clicking sounds which were not audible when at the copse. So Kevin and Colin went back up to the copse later that day with another tape recorder. Again the same thing happened. They checked and found it was a fairly regular pattern. To make certain that it was not interference on the tape they took recordings at the Fountain Centre and nothing showed up on the tape recordings. It was therefore reasonable to assume that it must have been from an outside influence.

On the Tuesday evening all three took part in a sky-watch. Kevin and Colin went up to the barn, the aim being to see if more

mysterious sounds would appear on the tape recording. It was decided this time to leave the recorder running for ten minutes in complete silence.. The sky-watch was unsuccessful and they returned to Fountain Centre to play back the tape. This time no clicks were evident but a series of bumping sounds were on the tape and these had not been apparent at the time of recording.

On Thursday, 28th, Colin and Chris returned to the barn area of the copse. This time a recording of what seemed to be a heart beating was obtained. The atmosphere around was heavy. A return visit to Cradle Hill that night at 7.00pm found the atmosphere again heavy. All three went to the copse. The heart beat was again recorded and on the way down back from the copse Kevin said, "We felt as if we were being scrutinised." When down at the white gate, Colin began to feel uneasy and to quote the tape recording : "Kev, Chris, move away for a moment would you?" When this was done, Colin felt as if someone was breathing down onto him. When we returned to him this sensation passed away. When the exercise was repeated the result was the same... On starting to move off the hill they all felt that someone wanted to talk to them and was now following them. The impression faded when they reached the lights of Warminster. When at Star House Colin felt as if someone was breathing on him, heart beats were again recorded, but when Kevin and Chris were near it faded away. As they walked through the grounds of the House "someone" running pushed past Colin causing him to lose his balance - this "someone" was invisible and yet the bump had been from "someone" tall, quite solid and of normal weight. If this seems far fetched to you the three persons concerned still possess the tape recordings as evidence. Could this have been the mysterious "night walker."

Knock, Knock, Whos There?

A report from Chris Hardwick, Andy Lee and Soteris Georgiou - Monday, November 1st 1976.

We had been travelling around Warminster during the day when Chris decided he wanted to take some movie shots of Cradle Hill. We arrived at 4.45pm and were filming the hill and copse for about 45mins. At 5.30pm we returned to the car (Austin 1100) to warm up as it was a cold day. After about 5 minutes our attention was drawn to a peculiar soft thumping from what appeared to be the roof. We heard seven thumps in succession.

After a lengthy period of debate and attempting to simulate the
