John Michael Powell, pig farmer, aged 30, of Badorgan Farm, Upton Lovel, was again remanded on bail, until Nov. 16th when he appeared at Warminster Court on three charges.

He was charged, that between Aug. 19th and 21st 1976 at Bishopstrow he destroyed by fire a building belonging to Mr Lawrence J. 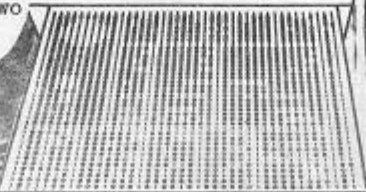

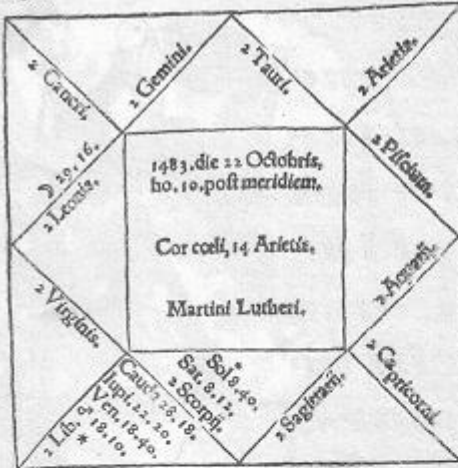

ASTROLOGY EXPLAINED - No. 3,

 Chart Types.



Your Ascendant or Rising Sign is not very often the same sign as your Sun Sign. Hence, we may have a Gemini person with Capricorn rising. This will produce someone quite different from a Gemini person with Pisces rising, which is why one can know two Gemini people who are totally different.

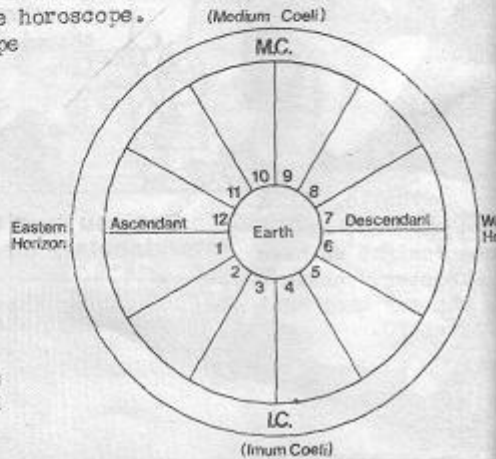
Twins, who are born perhaps twenty minutes apart can also show this difference, one being a Gemini with Cancer rising, the other born as the ascendant changes and having Leo rising.

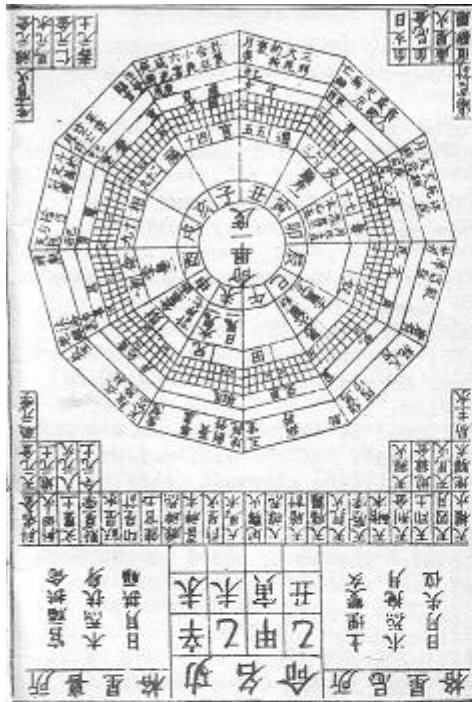
Unless one is born at the same time, date and place as someone else, most people are quite individualistic as regards their horoscopes. The ascendant is a very important factor in a horoscope, for it reveals the persons temperament, just as the Sun sign reveals the persons individuality, and the Moon the emotional nature. The ascendant is the astrological way in which a person expresses their ego.

Natal astrology relates to the birth of the individual. The chart is erected, showing the actual positions of the Sun, Moon, Ascendant, and the other planets at the exact moment of the persons birth. This chart is called the horoscope.

The shape of this horoscope has changed over the years, from being a square type, shown above: actually being the chart of Martin Luther, drawn in 1548; to the round type shown right: which shows the outline shape of the chart before the data is entered.

The Chinese form of horoscope is shown right (on page 21), this still uses the same twelve divisions called 'houses', which we shall discuss in a future edition.

'That's not our bump says the Ministry', Western Daily Press 18th

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Military aircraft have been ruled out as the cause of the nine o'clock Thing. The Defence Ministry yesterday denied supersonic fighters caused the nightly bump.

Concorde has already been cleared. Neither the French nor the English aircraft was in the air when the noise was heard, slightly ahead of schedule, on Tuesday night.

But last night, an aircraft was flying over Somerset when the boom was heard in many parts of the West at seven minutes past nine.

Mr James Overly, of Kilve near Bridgwater, said the noise could have been made by a supersonic aircraft. "We lived near Farnborough for several years and this sort of thing was an everyday occurrence there. This sounds exactly like supersonic flying.

"Tonight I heard a double bang followed by the whine of an aircraft. The bang was loud enough to cause vibrations". But the military was adamant. "We certainly have no trace of any military aircraft activity that could explain it, and in any case this is nothing like a sonic boom," said a Defence Ministry spokesman. "They tend to be more of a sharp report, and this is a long rumbling sound." The boom, heard in the West as far apart as Plymouth and Salisbury, has reached the ears of Avon Councillor Mrs Jean Pitt at her home in Chew Magna. "We didn't hear it on Tuesday night but there have been times when it has been very loud indeed, enough to make the dogs go barking about the place," she said.

Mr Peter Paget who runs an Unidentified Flying Object Research Centre in Warminster, Wiltshire, put forward a new theory last night.

"There has been a lot of UFO activity in the south of the country over the last few days," he said. "UFOs travel at very high speeds in a vacuum and this noise could be caused by the air rushing in to fill the space when the vehicle has passed." Mr Paget, who with his wife Jane, produce a monthly UFO magazine said, there was a UFO landing at Winchester on Sunday night .....

.....Bristol University scientist will travel to North Petherton, near Bridgwater, again tomorrow to listen for the boom. They will be headed by Mr Thomas Lawson, a reader in industrial aerodynamics. He first heard the noise on Monday night from the North Petherton home of Sedgemoor district engineer Mr George Lawrence.

Now the birds have joined in the protest over the mystery boom that rumbles in the West sky every night. The noises are rustling the feathers of roosting pheasants. And nesting birds are being woken up by low frequency sounds humans cannot hear.

The nine o'clock noise is upsetting pheasants reared at Somerset county councils farm institute in Cannington, near Bridgwater.

Mr Sidney Cable, who lives nearby, said the birds become restless about 15 seconds before the boom. Doctor Robert Adams, one of the two Bristol University researchers trying to trace the source of the noise, said yesterday he had heard several reports of birds being disturbed. "They seem to hear low frequency sounds which occur just before the boom that is audible to us. Just because many of these sounds are outside human range, it does not mean they are inaudible to animals. And they are probably more sensitive to low frequency noise than we are.

Dr Adams and his colleague Mr Thomas Lawson have had hundreds of letters about the boom from all over the West. But they are unlikely to come to a decision about its cause until the end of the week, when the data has been fed into the university's computer. Despite growing beliefs that Concorde is to blame, Dr Adams refused to speculate yesterday. "I have a pretty strong suspicion as to what is causing it but until we have worked this thing out scientifically," I am not prepared to say," he said. "But it is certainly not caused by the conventional over-flying of super-sonic aircraft."

Listeners using sophisticated equipment to record the noise in various parts of the West heard it again at about 9.10pm on Saturday. Only a faint rumbling noise disturbed the skies in the West last night but birds near where I was listening began stirring just before.

The rumbling came at 9.14pm, and at 9.15pm an aircraft flew very high overhead. But the boom went on overtime last night. Nearly an hour behind schedule, four rattlers shuddered windows in Somerset just after 10.20pm.

The Thing that goes bump in the night took on an eerie orange glow last night. I saw it as I listened out for the unexplained noises that have baffled the West from a vantage point high in the Blackdown Hills, near Taunton. I saw a silent, ball-shaped orange light speed high across the cloudless sky for a second and a half, before vanishing like a Guy Fawkes night rocket. It happened at 9.03pm just two minutes ahead of the normal time for the mystery noise, like distant gunfire, which has rattled windows and baffled experts from Bristol to Cornwall.

But last night the Bump was early. It came at one minute to nine in several rumbles. They were faint, but identical to the sounds I had heard in North Petherton on Sunday and Monday.

The orange glow matches almost exactly a sighting from a man in Combe Down, Bath, who saw it in Wiltshire a week ago.

Regular bumps have been heard as far afield as Cornwall and the Forest of Dean, yesterday people in the village of Downton, near Salisbury reported hearing it too.

## Book Review; The Flying Saucerers

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By Arthur Shuttlewood. Published by Sphere Books Ltd, illustrated, paperback, 65p. First edition: 20th Nov. 1976.

With Nationwide distribution throughout the UK and on the front line up of every bookshop 'Flying Saucerers' is going to put Warminster back on the map with the general public.

Following as a natural sequel to 'The Warminster Mystery' rather than as a progression from books 2 and 3, it is the same formula of well documented sightings and events with theories and readers letters included for deeper speculation. There are no answers in the books of which this is number 4, but plenty of background detail.

Well recommended as a contributing study to the British ufo scene, however it does include some irrelevant items and letters, but a book well suited to what is needed to convince people that UFOs, Warminster, and UFO people are to be given serious consideration.

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
