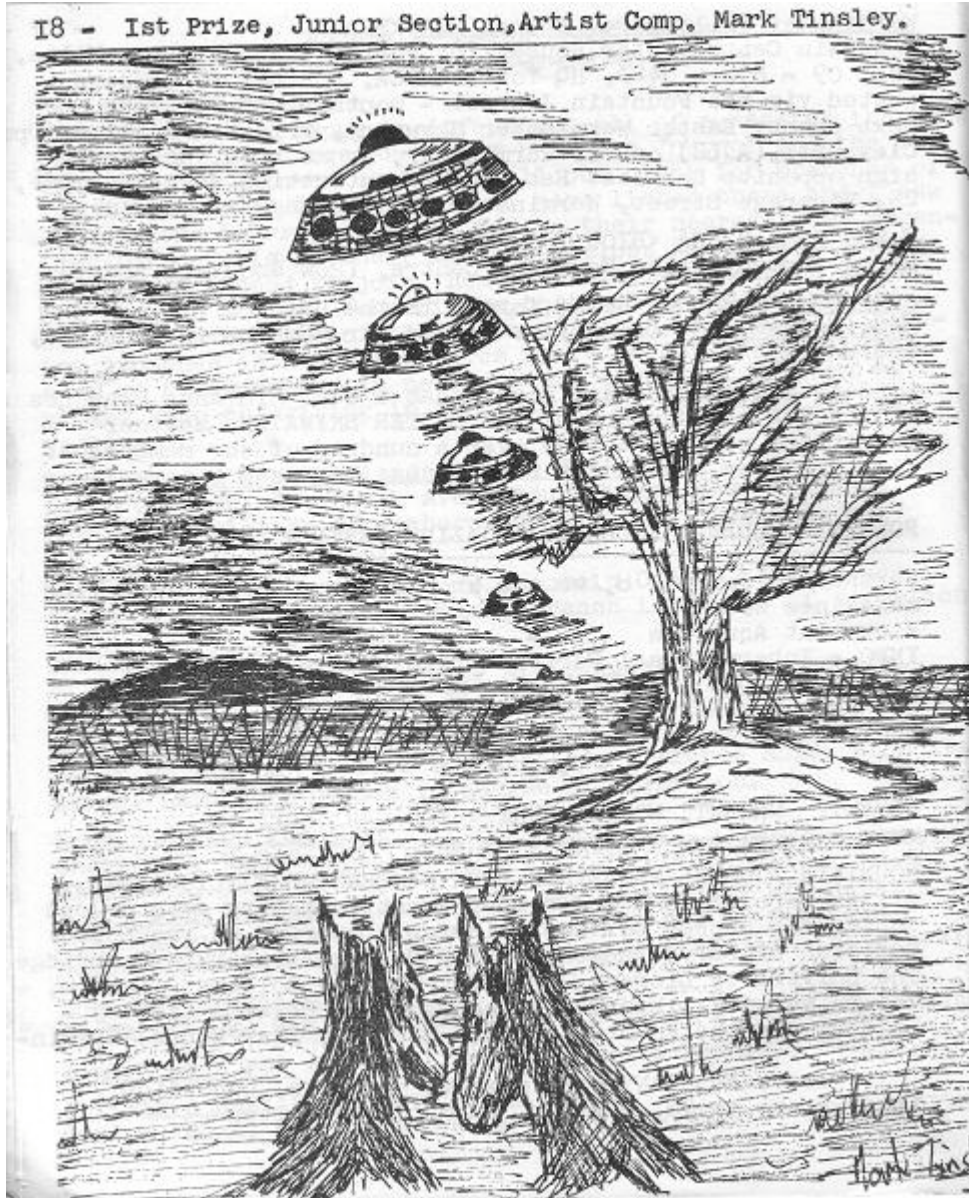

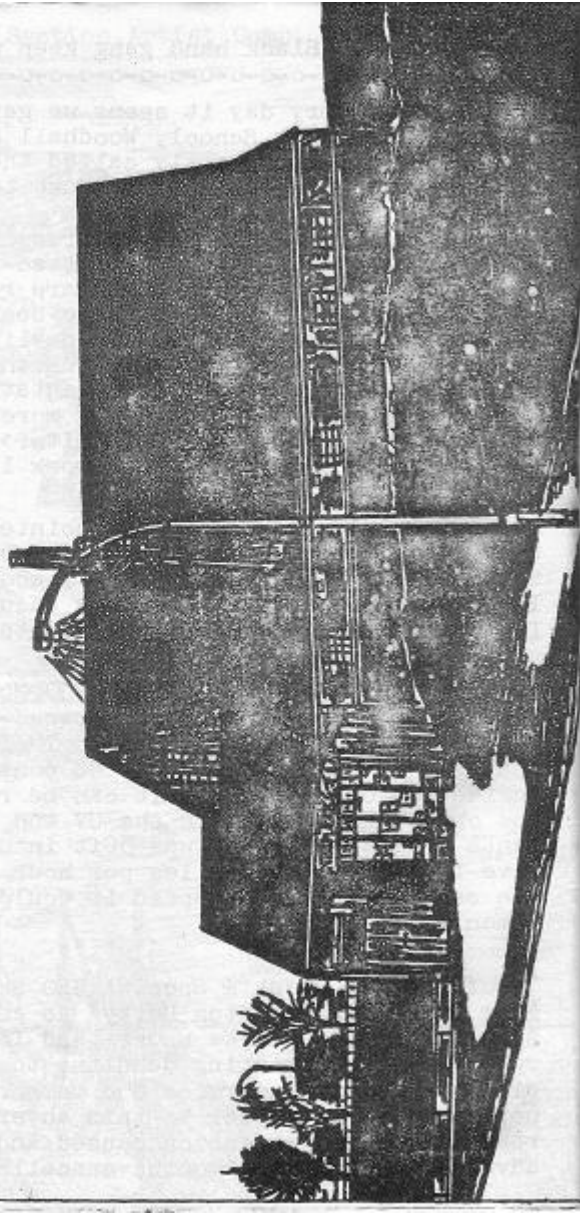

Analysis of the photo by our US consultant suggest that a reflection or optical fault can be ruled out. Assuming that the object was bright in the UV end of the spectrum, Measurements indicate that it was 50ft in dia and was travelling at five to six thousand miles per hour when it was 'frozen' by the camera. At such a speed it would be too fast for the human eye to follow.

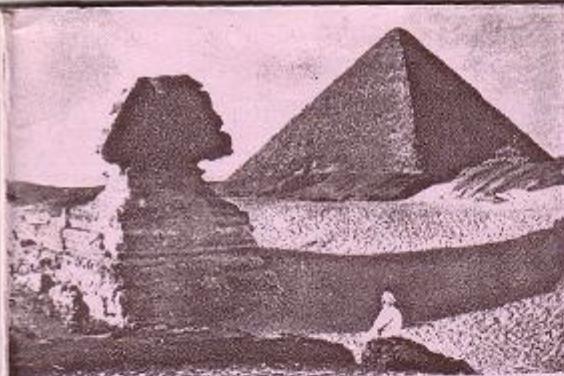

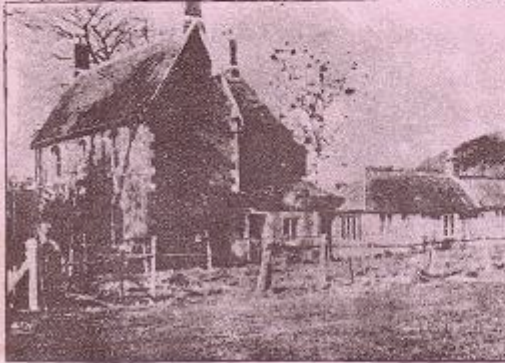
