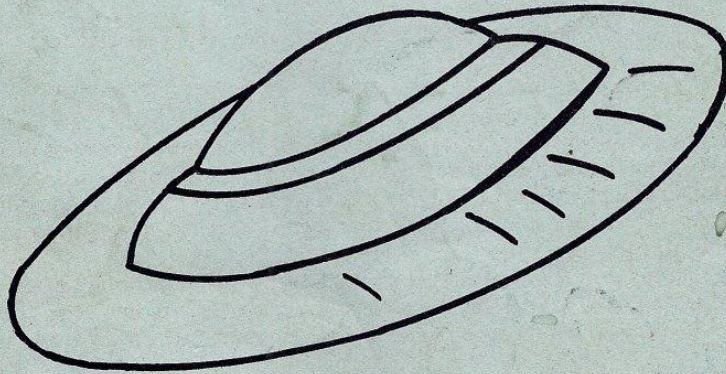

Feb 1977. 11pm.

Mr.Dave Tuplin driving from Burgh-Le-Marsh along the 6mile stretch of road to Skegness, where he lives. He noticed approximately 80ft in the air, a bright light travelling also towards Skegness in front of him.

The light was zig-zagging above the right hand side of the road, he chased after it. It suddenly seemed to disappear, then it reappeared behind him doing the same manouvers as before. Mr Tuplin said there was no noise at all. Driving home the next evening on the same road, and at about the same time, he saw the object again, doing the same as before. Another Skegness lady saw the same thing from her home, she reported it to the local TV station.

Incident two

August 10th 1976 2.40a.m.

Mandy Smith - 16year old school girl.

Awakened from a light sleep by a loud humming noise, which seemed to come and go. Looking from her bedroom window(which faces south) she saw over Coronation Walk a wooded area South of Skegness, Just over tree tops a dome shaped object surrounded by vivid light. Mandy described it as like a Magnesium Flare. Trees were swaying violently under the object. Plainly see leaves on trees from the light which was pulsating.

Suddenly object moved quickly, There was a bright Flash and a loud bang and it had gone. Upon opening a gift given her by a Mr. R.W.Greaves, Arther Shuttlewood's book Warminster Mystery. She pointed to a photograph("Thats what I saw") of a domed shaped U.F.O.

Why Schools?

More and more U.F.O incidents are being reported by children and more often than not these happenings are occurring over schools, the most likely spot to find children. Before we delve any deeper into this let us take a look at some of these strange and ineptible sightings January 24th. 1977. Steeple Ashton School, Nr. Trowbridge.

"I think it was a space ship, It had a hole through the middle but it was sort of hard round the outside. Clouds couldn't pass through the outside but they could go through the middle though". That was how one young lad described the mystery object observed by fifty to sixty pupils, the headmaster, teachers and parents, on ~~then~~ that memorable January morning. When asked was it hovering the same boy said "No it was just going round like a whirl, Just goin over".

Another description went on to say "It was a sort of blackish grey ring going across the sky, it was a dark on one side and in the bottom it had a sort of little line through it".

The headmaster interviewed by the television, and UFO INFO EXCHANGE LIBRARY said "There was not any chance of it being a helicopter and no chance of it being a aircraft, I'M just glad that a lot of people saw it at the same time as I did".

Wincanton 24th January 1977

On the same day as the above occurrence children from a school in Wincanton witnessed a similar event at about the same time between 8.15a

and 9.00am. To quote from one of the children Laura Hussey, I saw a yellowish light in the sky, Around the edge s were a faint red line and red blobs going around the middle.

Beaumont, Wiltshire 1977
Fourteen children observed a mystery object which had landed in a field near the village school, most agreed that it was a disc.

silver coloured cigar shaped machine with a dome, Some mentioned Red or Orange lights. This event was backed up by a woman living near the school who claimed she had seen a bright light in the sky, also three other women came forward. Twenty children at Hubberston School Milford Haven reported a cigar shaped object in the sky so adding more credit to the BroadHaven story.

Cromer Secondary School December 1976

Black on top and silver underneath was how pupils at Cromer Secondary school described the UFO they saw in December last year.

Edenhurst School Newcastle February 1977

Pupils saw an object moving in between two clouds following a straight path, 100 children and two teachers watched a slow moving colour changing U.F.O For more than five minutes, one teacher Deborah Foster said the object had a door or holes. The general description was it was like two dinner plates flying face to face.

West Lavington Dauntsey School, Last Term

Details Later, but several pupils sighted.

Warminster Feb 14th 1977

Two school children sighted a cigarette shaped UFO followed by a golden disc emitting golden sparks, the cigarette shape one disappeared into a cloud, the disc kept on going into the distance.

North Wales 8th September 1971 (Into History)

U.F.O White oval shaped partly obscured by haze, watched for 20-30mins watched by several schoolboys on the beach.

Date: Uncertain, but July 1967, and moon was in last quarter,

Eclipse, glowing slightly less brightly than the moon; motionless for 12 minutes, then headed slightly East of North and disappeared behind hills in 1 minite. Appeared 9.54pm, disappeared 10.07pm approx.

Fix 1; 9.57pm bearing 47° magnetic from centre of town, elevation 74°
Fix 2; 10.02pm, bearing 38° magnetic from a point 2.3 miles out of town centre. at 155° magnetic, elevation 76° . Estimated length 2° , width less than 1° .

On the evening of the 27th of November, 1976 at approx 10.40 pm, at Cradle Hill Warminster, there were ten skywatchers, including Arthur Shuttlewood, Richard Gardner, Chris Trubridge, and his wife Pauline, who contributed this article.

Chris was the first to see an object, and alerted the others to look towards the Golf Clubhouse, which stands on the highest point of Elm Hill in a Westerly direction. The object he had seen had appeared in the sky about 5° above the centre of Elm Hill and approximately 5 - 10 yard to the right of the clubhouse. The object moved quickly West to East following the contours of Elm and Cradle Hills, with an amber colour. As the object came closer, it became obvious that it was a UFO to all present. When the UFO neared the copse at Cradle Hill it suddenly disappeared over the brow of the hill.

At this point in time, everyone was very excited, so Chris Trubridge and Richard Gardner decided to investigate further. Chris and Richard ran up the track leading to the copse at the top of the hill, in the hope of getting a better view of the object; when they reached the top of the hill they were amazed at what they saw there in the valley between Cradle Hill and Upton Co-Down, which is the next hill over from Cradle in a N.W. direction and about 1 mile from where they were standing. The object was hovering low in the valley and approximately 10 feet above the ground. It stayed stationary for 3 to 4 minutes. It then began to rise into the air, increasing in speed as it did so, rapidly giving off a bright amber light changing to an orange light and back to amber as it shot up into the star-filled sky. It was soon lost from sight as it rose up in a N.W. direction, and finally a westerly direction. You can imagine how they both felt as they walked slowly back to the group at the bottom of the hill.

We would like to thank Chris and his wife for this very exact description of what they saw, and for giving us this opportunity to pass on the information to our readers.

WHY WE MAY ALL BE FLYING IN SAUCERS BY 1990

Researchers at the Lawrence Livermore Laboratory in California this month plan to focus 24 glass lasers on a 1 mm pellet of heavy hydrogen. Almost instantaneously, the hydrogen will become a long streak of plasma with a temperature of 100million °C, expanding at about 320 Km. per second. According to two young Frenchmen, we may all be riding around in flying saucers by 1990 as a result of this almost inconceivable event.

The two, - doctors of science at the French Government's Laboratoire D'Astronomie Spatiale near Marseilles, - have apparently learned how to suppress the shock waves which flying objects make in that surprisingly solid substance, air. Theoretically, this would make it possible to to move about in the atmosphere quite soundlessly and at enormous acceleration, changing course abruptly when desired. It seems a perfect description of a flying saucer, which is exactly what the machine they envisage would look like. Petit and Viton have applied existing principles of aerodynamics and electromagnetics to produce an apparently unassailable mathematical model which explains how flying saucers fly. They have presented it to a fascinated audience at France's prestigious Academie des Sciences, and rejected sponsorship by the army (which wanted to keep the technique secret) in order to publish discovery. In windtunnel tests, at Toulouse, they succeeded in filming the partial suppression of the shock wave created by a model flying saucer.

According to Petit, "It all comes down to standard physics." An electromagnetic field can create a low pressure area under an aerodyne, or flying saucer. This gives lift. To this can be related the peculiar property of plasma (produced for the first time in the United States in March of this Year, just ahead of the Soviet Union). Plasma's magnetic field is frozen inside it while it expands at unimaginable speeds, producing an electrical current. Using Plasma, a belt of free air is created. The molecules of air in front of this belt are pushed aside when a normal aerofoil passes through the atmosphere fast enough to break the sound barrier.

"We're not saying that we've solved the problem" says Petit, "but we think we have cracked the principle behind the effects observed in Unidentified flying objects (UFO's) all over the world." And he predicts Science is going so fast today that "I could envisage working models within 15 years".
