Expert Who Was U.S. Govt's Top Photo Interpreter Says:

' I'VE SEEN A GENUINE FILM OF UFOs THAT COULD NOT HAVE BEEN
FAKED '.

Arthur Lundahl, the government's top photo interpreter who told President Kennedy that Russian missiles were in Cuba, says he's seen a film of UFOs which he believes is totally genuine.

"I've seen a genuine film of UFOs that, as a photo anylist I believe could not have been faked", revealed Lundahl, former director of the governments National Photographic Interpretation Center in Washington, D.C., which anylises photographs for the C.I.A. and other intelligence agencies.

Lundahl, 61, studied the original of a UFO film, a movie film, shot in Tremonton, Utah, by official Navy photographer Delbert Newhouse in 1952. His conclusion: "These were indeed UFOs. The film showed objects of unknown size moving at high speeds - one of our estimates was 1,700 miles per hour - and they were changing colours from reds to blues to greens and back to reds.

"One of the UFOs seemed to get lost from the formation. It went away and then came back again. They seemed to be flat and circular in shape. We tested that film, about 1,600 frames of 16mm Kodachrome motion picture film, for several hundred man-hours on a frame projector.

"We anylised each frame and looked for possible doctoring. We looked for flecks of dust that might have caused refracting, even for holes in the bellows of the camera. But we found nothing to explain what appeared on the film.

"Some of my co-workers at the Naval Interpretation Laboratory took the film and showed it to Robertson panel, an expert group of scientists who met under the auspices of the CIA in 1953".

Lundahl stressed: "There is no doubt in my mind this film was not faked. It isn't easy to fake a movie film as it is a still photograph, the doctoring on a film would have showed up as blobs on a screen.

"I'm convinced that this sighting was something that simply goes beyond what we know of on Earth. We spent hours poring over that film looking for possible explanations - birds, planes, reflections from Earth - but gradually, scientifically, we wiped out every possible one.

"Obviously, moving at 1,700 miles per hour in 1952 it couldn't have been an aircraft. - either on line or in research by any government. We had access to that data and knew it could not have been that. And we had experts determine that it was not the reflection of any light source or any heavenly body.

" I've also met Delbert Newhouse, the Navy photographer who shot the film, and he's not a crank or a drunk or a publicity hunter".

Recalled Newhouse, 63 - today retired and living in San Diego, Calif:

"My wife and I were driving from Washington D.C. to Oregon on July 2, 1952, when we saw these unusual lights in the sky. They were like nothing I'd ever seen before. There were 15 UFOs all bright, aluminum - coloured objects turning into the sunlight. My camera was inside the suitcase in the back of the station wagon, and I had to open another suitcase to get the film magazine and load the camera. By that time the objects had moved off some. "

Lundahl retired from a distinguished career in 1973 and a year later won the Knight Commander of the British Empire for his outstanding liaison work with England in World War 2.

"When I first heard about this film, in 1953, I never thought about UFOs", he told the ENQUIRER. "but now I believe in them and I believe there's something definitely out there".

..... Government Is Keeping Startling Evidence Secret.....

Americas Top newscaster Walter Cronkite is absolutely convinced of the existence of UFOs - because of secret information revealed to him by space scientists and high level government officials. And much of the evidence has been covered up by the government, Cronkite said in an exclusive interview with the NATIONAL ENQUIRER.

" I sincerely believe there are Unidentified Flying Objects in the skies " declared the famed broadcaster. Among the Cronkite bases his startling conclusions on is:

- 1-A bizarre spacecraft that hovered over a missile test site - and beamed down an eerie green ray that froze a leaping dog in midair.
- 2-The 'Earthshaking' sighting of a huge cylindrical object by the crew of Apollo IX during man's first flight to land on the moon.
- 3-A strange flying object observed by astronaut James McDivitt as he circled Earth in his GEMINI space capsule.
- 4-Official Air Force reports of hundreds of UFOs that cannot be explained away as natural phenomena.

In his New York network office an amazing candid Cronkite confided, " One of the most incredible cases of a UFO sighting that I have ever heard about was the Andros Island sighting. The story was told to me by a person of very high authority, whom I can't name but believe totally. "

" In the mid-60s there was to be a missile tracking station test in the Caribbean for many foreign dignitaries, but the test was cancelled because of an incident hours before the test was due to start. "

The incident began when a radar operator at the site - which is about 150 miles east of the Florida Keys - notice that the quiet night sky had suddenly turned a bright green, Cronkite recalled.

" He ran outside and to his amazement sighted a huge cylindrical craft hovering above. He watched the missile site's mascot dog run towards the craft barking and snapping angrily. The animal leapt into the air like an attacking cugar, but a shaft of light (green) beamed down on the dog. The animal was locked into a frozen position by the ray - unable to move. The radar operator reported that the dog was there in midair for several seconds. Then the ray of green light was drawn back into the ship and the dog was dropped back to the pavement "

The man ran for his movie camera and shot eight minutes of film - during which time two more UFOs flew in and hovered over the first craft, said Cronkite. " Then the silent craft quickly sped off ", he added.

Following the incident, officials seized the eight minute film and high level military officers flew in to de-brief the man who had shot it.

" Later the man tried to see the film, but it had been confiscated. The dog and other animals on the island were removed by a PT boat for possible radioactive side effects. They also took samples from the many dead fish that washed ashore. Subsequently, the operator was told that what he'd seen was classified information. Two other radar operators - assigned to monitor the tests on another nearby island - reported their screens blacked out for 8 minutes, and they were transferred.

" Everything about that has been kept a total secret - and it's not the first time that this type of incident has occurred "

Another startling occasion, Apollo XI, astronaut Neil Armstrong found that all his astronaut training hadn't prepared him for what he was to encounter in outer space.

" En - route for the world's first moon landing, Armstrong and his crew transmitted some Earth - shaking information. And I was there to hear it for myself ", recalled Cronkite.

" Armstrong claimed to have spotted a huge cylindrical object which was rotating or tumbling between their ship and the moon. It's officially

recorded in the NASA record vaults that Armstrong indicated he went to take photographs but the object vanished as quickly as he'd first seen it.

" Neil Armstrong is not a man given to fanciful imagination and wasn't just one of the crew that saw it. They all did, and you have to respect those men.

" Many UFOs have been reported by our astronauts. The first sighting took place in June 1965 on the GEMINI mission. Astronaut James McDivitt told me he saw an object in front of his spacecraft that he couldn't identify. He described it as a white cylindrical shape - with a white pole jutting out from one corner.

" He couldn't estimate it's size because depth perception in space is not very good. McDivitt grabbed two cameras and shot some film, and photographs. He claims the films were flown to Houston after they landed safely in the Atlantic "

" But to his astonishment he never saw the object on the pictures that were officially released. Even the military's own documented case support the existence of UFOs ", said Cronkite.

" I know for a fact that when the Air Force recently turned over a series of declassified UFO reports to the National Archives there were still some 700 cases they could not explain away in natural terms."

There are people in the highest places of power who also believe in UFOs, including Senator Barry Goldwater, who is a retired Major General in the Air Force reserve, Cronkite continued.

" Senator Goldwater told me that he believes the Earth has been and is currently being visited and is under observation by extraterrestrial intelligence ", revealed the veteran broadcaster.

And he noted that when President Ford was a member of the House in 1966 he demanded that a congressional investigation be made following a flurry of UFO sightings in his home state of Michigan.

Although Cronkite himself has never seen a UFO, he recalls vividly an eyewitness account given to him by a CBS executive.

" He drew for me the outlines of a cigar - shaped object that he'd seen twice near his Long Island summer home on the Atlantic coast. I respect this CBS executive and I know that he wasn't trying to hoax me - he was telling the truth. I believe him and I told him that nobody as ever given me proof that UFOs are fiction.

I often gazed out of airline windows when I travelled - in the hope of spotting one for myself. That would be a scoop "

The CBS newsman noted that President-elect Carter is a firm believer in UFOs. Carter revealed his belief - and recounted one night he actually saw a UFO, - exclusively in the JUNE 8 issue of the ENQUIRER.

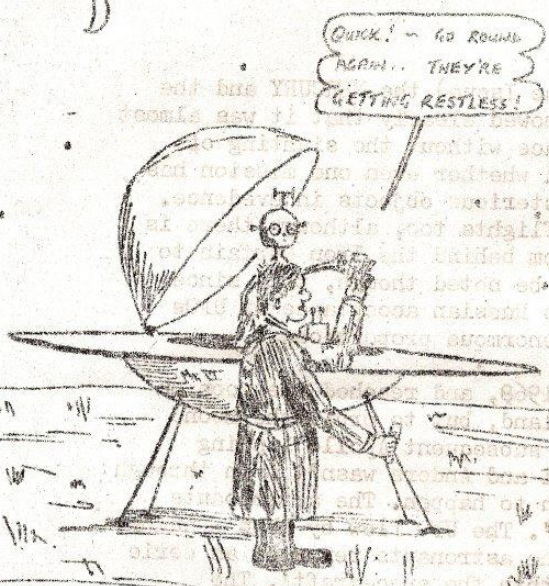
In that same issue, Carter pledged: "If I become President I'll make every peice of information this country has about UFO sightings available to the public and the scientists. "

Commented Cronkite, " That will certainly make news because there must be hundreds of other sighting cases that have never been made public - this will become big news, and perhaps convince skeptics that UFOs are very real "

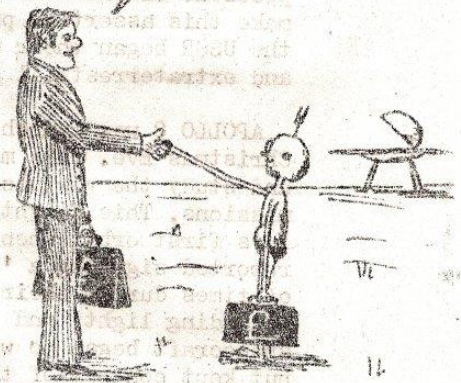

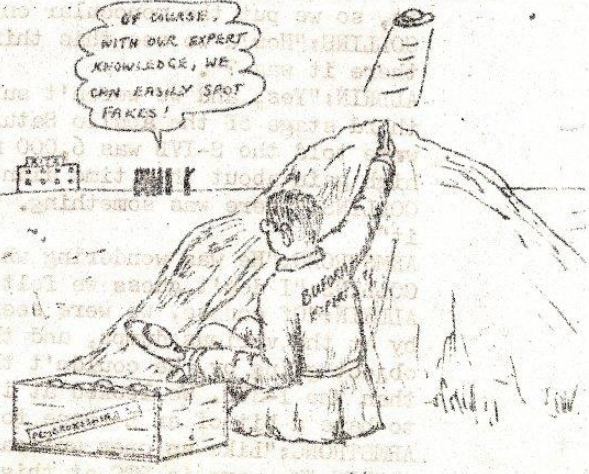

SPACECRAFT AND UFO SIGHTINGS IN OUTER SPACEPART TWO

In the first part of this article (June Issue) the MERCURY and the GEMINI space missions that we covered showed clearly that it was almost impossible for a spaceflight to take place without the sighting of one or more UFOs. Indeed, it is doubtful whether even one mission has taken place without the accompanying mysterious objects in evidence.

This probably applies to the Russian flights too, although there is precious little information released from behind the Iron Curtain to make this assertion positive. It should be noted though, that since the USSR began their manned spaceflights Russian acceptance of UFOs and extraterrestrial life has grown by enormous proportions.

APOLLO 8 was launched in December of 1968, and reached the moon on Christmas Eve. This mission was not to land, but to orbit the moon and study the various landing sites for subsequent Apollo landing missions. This flight, by Borman, Lovell and Anders wasn't even through it's first orbit when weird things began to happen. The astronauts reported sighting a 'disc-shaped object'. The UFO flew by them a number of times during their first orbit and the astronauts reported an eerie 'blinding light' and 'a wave of heat within the spacecraft'. The spacecraft began to wobble all over the place and the astronauts all but kept control of the ship. During all this drama they and Ground Control heard very odd noises through their radio communications link up which they describe as 'weird garble-intolerable high frequency noises'. NASA reported that the spacecrafts 'pitch and yaw' problem was caused by high gravity points on the moon called MASCONS. This may very well be true - Even so, that they saw a disc - shaped UFO, saw a blinding light, felt an intense heat and heard strange noises there is little doubt.

The historical APOLLO XI mission was launched on July 16th, 1969, with Neil Armstrong, Edwin 'Buzz' Aldrin and Michael Collins on board. It was the first landing from Earth onto another planetary body. They were a third of the way there en-route to the moon, when they sighted a strange object in front of their craft. Here follows the de-briefing discussion between the astronauts following their return to Earth:

ALDRIN:"The first unusual thing that we saw I guess was one day out or something pretty close to the moon. It had a sizable dimension to it, so we put the monocular on it."

COLLINS:"How'd we see this thing?, Did we just look out the window and there it was?"

ALDRIN:"Yes, and we weren't sure but what it might be the S-IVB (the third stage of the Apollo Saturn V rocket). We called the ground and ~~were~~ told the S-IVB was 6,000 miles away. We had a problem with the high gain about this time didn't we?"

COLLINS:"There was something. We felt a bump or maybe I just imagined it".

ARMSTRONG:"He was wondering whether the MESA had come off".

COLLINS:"I don't guess we felt anything".

ALDRIN:"Of course, we were seeing all sorts of little objects going by at the various dumps, and then we happened to see this one bright object going by. We couldn't think of anything else it could be other than the I-SVB. We looked at it through the monocular and it seemed to have a bit of an L-shape to it".

ARMSTRONG:"Like an open suitcase".

ALDRIN:"We were in PTC at this time so each of us had a chance to

take a look at this and it certainly seemed to be within our vicinity and of a very sizable dimension".

ARMSTRONG: "We should say it was right at the limit of the resolution of the eye. It was very difficult to tell just what shape it was. And there was no way to tell the size without knowing the range, or the range without knowing the size".

ALDRIN: "So then we got down in the LEM and started looking for it in the optics. We were grossly misled, because with the sextant off focus what we saw appeared to be a cylinder."

ARMSTRONG: "Or really two rings".

ALDRIN: "Yes".

COLLINS: "No. It looked like a hollow cylinder to me. It didn't look like two connected rings (has suggested by Armstrong). You could see this thing tumbling and, when it came around end-on, you could look right down in it's guts. It was a hollow cylinder. But then you could change the focus on the sextant and it would be replaced by this open book shape. It was really weird".

ALDRIN: "I guess there's not too much more to say about it other than it wasn't a cylinder".

COLLINS: "It was during the period when we thought it was a cylinder that we enquired about the S-IVB and we'd almost convinced ourselves that that's what it had to be. But we don't have anymore conclusions than that really. The fact that we didn't see it much past this period - we really don't have a conclusion as to what it might have been, how big it was or how far away it was. It was something that wasn't part of the urine dump, we're pretty sure of that".

This object still remains a mystery to this day - at least as far as the public are concerned.

Further into the mission, as the craft neared the moon, and then on for a few orbits, as on a number of other missions, both astronauts and ground control at Houston began to hear weird noises through the communications link-up. Houston were mystified enough to enquire: "You don't have anybody else up there with you?".

The noises - sirens, bells, whistles and buzzes - put everyone, and in particular the astronauts - on edge. The noises came from outside the spacecraft and either near, or on the moon. It was ascertained that they were radio signals.

One unconfirmed report, which if true, is sensational, was given by OTTO BINDER, NASA science writer and holder of an honorary degree given to him by the Space Agency for services of outstanding merit. Mr Binder reports that:

"It was presumably when the two moon walkers, Armstrong and Aldrin, were making their rounds some distance from the LEM, that Armstrong

clutched Aldrin's arm and exclaimed 'WHAT WAS IT. WHAT THE HELL WAS IT. THATS ALL I WANT TO KNOW!'. Then came the following exchange:

MISSION CONTROL: "What's there.....malfunction.....(garble)..
...Mission Control calling Apollo XI.....

APOLLO XI: "These babies were huge Sir. Enormous...Oh God, you wouldn't believe it.....I'm telling you there are other spacecraft out there...
...lined up on the far side of the crater....They're on the moon watching us!....."

Otto Binder ends by saying that there has - understandably - been no confirmation of this sensational report, by NASA or any other authority.

In the previous article mention was made of two UFOs seen following APOLLO 12 by European astronomers, and subsequently confirmed by the astronauts - Conrad, Gordon and Bean - as being seen by them at a distance of 132,000 miles from Earth.

An Earth-Spacecraft exchange the following day (Saturday, 15th November) went as follows:

APOLLO 12: "We have had an object which is in the same place all the time and we have had it with us ever since

yesterday and it seemed to be tagging along with us ".

Mission control suggested it could be possibly the S-IVB third stage booster, or one or two of the protective sla panels. It was ascertained that the object was not the booster. In anycase, one booster does not make two objects - and there were actually TWO objects found to be tagging Apollo 12.

MISSION CONTROL: " OK, we'll go back to our drawing boards ".

APOLLO 12: " The object is very bright and it is obviously something that is tumbling. It is tumbling at one and one half revs per second or at least it is flashing us about that. Dick is going to tell you what star it is nearing. He is messing with his charts right now ".

Mission control could not discover what these strange objects were, not knowing their speed or trajectory, but they said they would assume them to be FRIENDLY! One of the objects then shot away at a high speed.

Then, as the spacecraft got closer to the moon the now familiar weird noises were heard over the radio link.

MISSION CONTROL " The astronauts must be talking to somebody strange up there ", was one of their comments.

Then, a little later, between the astronauts:

BEAN " Do you hear a lot of background noises Pete ? ".

CONRAD " Kind of static and things ? ".

BEAN " I keep hearing whistling ".

CONRAD " That's what I hear. OK. ".

GORBON " Hey, Houston, Do you hear this constant beep in the background ? ".

MISSION CONTROL " That's affirmative. We've heard it now for about the last forty five minutes ".

GORDON " That's right, so have we. What is it ? ".

Nobody ever did find out what 'IT' was - or if they did they're not saying! .

At sometime near the end of the mission as the spacecraft neared Earth on their return, the astronauts sighted a bright flashing object below them, shining against the background of the Earth. Checks were made as the astronauts kept their eyes on this strange UFO. The object was about the relative size of Venus, and as big as any thunderstorm lightning flash they had observed up to that moment. The object was sighted above the Eastern coast of India but it subsequently disappeared and was never explained.

APOLLO 15 (David Scott, James Irwin and Alfred Worden), sighted some strange white objects as they approached the lunar surface in the LEM. They were not large objects, and the space agency consider it doubtful that they were of significance. They did not identify these objects.

Apollo 16 (Ken Mattingly, Charles Duke and John Young) had their sighting. Mattingly, as he orbited the lunar surface in the Command Module, reported sighting a flashing light that shot across the lunar sky and was lost below the horizon. The possibility of a meteorite was ruled out immediately. NASA scientist, Farouk El Baz said of this incident: " The one thing I cannot explain, that I do not know about, or what it could be are those enormous flashes of light. There's no question about it, they are very tremendous things, not comets, not natural. Three were seen over the Western part of the moon, one by Mattingly, on Apollo 16, and two by Evans and Harrison Schmitt on Apollo 17 ".

Apollo 17 saw what was a strange light on the surface of the moon, in the crater ORIENTALE. Mission control made the strange suggestion that it might be a Russian VOSTOK spacecraft - although these ships were not built to reach the moon. This suggestion was made in all seriousness, and Ronald Evans looked for it again on the next pass and marked it on the map.

Two UFOs were seen by Ron Evans on this mission, and Harrison Schmitt saw one. Photographs were taken of these sightings but have not yet been released.
