The five incidents I shall report occurred in March, April and June 1977:

1. Mrs. Pauline Coombs lives with her husband and three children in a tied cottage at BROADHAVEN. Mr. Coombs manages the farm for a local farmer. Both adults are down to earth, sensible people.
Towards the end of March, Mrs. Coombs was driving home in her car, accompanied by two of her children. It was late and the night very dark. As she drove down the lonely lane leading to her cottage, a ball of orange light appeared at the rear of the car, and kept pace with it. Alarmed, she accelerated, and reached the cottage in a state of shock. The light then vanished from sight. Her two children were petrified. Since this incident, she has become very nervous, and has suffered pains in her right upper arm and shoulder.
2. In early April, Mrs. Coombs and her family sat watching the TV. It was 11p.m. The curtains of the living room are always left open. All of a sudden, a light appeared at the window, and Mrs. C gasped as she saw an enormous being in a silvery suit looking in watching them. "He was huge - very tall - so much so I couldn't see all of his face. The top of the window hid it." The family were numb with fright. Mr. C would not go outside to investigate. Eventually, the "person" vanished, and Mr. C ventured outside with extreme caution. He searched the garden and surrounding area, but there was no trace of anyone.
3. A few days later the two girls, aged seven and nine, were playing roly-poly in the large field behind the cottage. They heard a strange buzzing sound, and were very scared when a thing "like two saucers stuck together" appeared in the far corner of the field. A ladder came down from the craft and a RED BOX was thrown out. Then two men emerged and walked about the field. They were dressed in silver paper suits commented the girls. The children remained where they were, too frightened to move. Shortly afterwards, the men re-entered the saucer and the ladder was hauled up. It then vanished from sight, although the red box remained on the grass. Curious now, the girls ran across, and, just as they were going to touch the box, it vanished. They ran back to the cottage and told their mother what had happened. This only made the mother more terrified than ever. Both children started vomiting, and had headaches. Next day, one of them had a painfully swollen ankle, although she had sustained no physical injury. The other had a painful rash on her arm. Even though these signs, were, in my humble opinion, indicative of radiation, the family doctor was neither called or consulted. The symptoms have since subsided. Mr. Coombs, on hearing the account of the children, went into the field and examined it. He told me, "There was a large circle of burned grass, about 18' diameter. It was as though someone had used a blowlamp on the grass there".
4. On the 30th. June, another phenomenon occurred, which frightened not only the Coombs family, but also a caller - a friend of the family. The caller came in through the open porchway of the cottage, and closed the glass door behind him. Mr. C was in the far room. He called to Mr. C who came into the hallway. The night was very dark and the lane is unlit. The caller shouted, "Good God, what's that". From outside the porchway and shining in through the closed glass door a very bright orange light pulsed. It lit up the place with its orange glow. Mrs. C came out of the lounge, terrified once more, and said "I can't stand much more of this". It lasted for quite a few minutes. The three trembled as they watched. When at last it vanished, they ventured outside, but saw nothing. They would have noticed a car's lights as it passed the window, but the lane leads to the farm and a dead end. Therefore it could not have been an earthly light.
5. On the night of 2nd. July, Mrs. Coombs looked outside and saw a large orange ball of light in the sky at 11.50.p.m. This is when she phoned Mr. R. Pugh (BUFORA), my host for the evening. I spoke to her on the phone and she told me that the ball was at that moment over Broadhaven Bay. Mrs. Coombs invited me to her home after my tel-

ephone conversation with her. It was then that the aforementioned reports were given me.

I found Mr. and Mrs. Coombs honest people. They certainly did not wish the resulting publicity from their experiences. I should, perhaps mention that this week (1/7/77), date of my reporting Mrs. Coombs had a personal call from two well dressed strangers who drove down to her home in a large grey Mercedes limousine. They told her that Mr. Pugh had sent them. As she has a very high regard for Mr. Pugh she admitted these men. I was present with Mr. Pugh when he decided ever having sent anyone to her. I did not think it wise to ask her the gist of their conversation, but I thought I should advise her to be on her guard against imposters in the future, and to demand to see their credentials so that she may ascertain their true identity. I also suggested she telephoned Mr. Pugh before she allowed any more strangers into the privacy of her home. She agreed that this was the sensible thing to do in future.

Professor Ziegler asserts that the main task is to organize systematic study of the phenomena from astronomical and meteorological observation. It will then probably become possible to determine whether the objects are of protoplasmic origin or come from another planet, he continues.

The second hypothesis merits serious consideration, to my mind, he stresses. The UFO phenomenon is a challenge to Mankind, he feels, and it is the duty of scientists to take up this challenge, to disclose the nature of the UFO and to establish the scientific truth. The Russian moves follow the example of the United States.

Public clamour in the USA led to a hearing on UFOs by the House Armed Services Committee in April 1966. The American Air Force contracted with the University of Colorado to conduct an independent and impartial investigation. This has a formidable array of consulting laboratories and specialists at its disposal, in hopes of coming upon concrete evidence.

A fragment of metal could be tested to see if it carries the radiation material acquired in space. Photographs obtained by various meteor monitoring networks can be analyzed to provide objective information on size, speed and direction. Discoloured material at an alleged landing site could be studied for evidence of an exotic or conventional propellant.

' REVEAL THE INFO!' Says Moonwalker/Senator HARRISON SCHMITT

Dr Harrison Schmitt will urge the government to open it's UFO files to the public.

UFO STATISTICS (Ministry of Defence)

Between the beginning of 1959, and the end of 1973 (after which - it is claimed - no further analysis was to be made), the government of the U.K. claim to have recieved 2308 reports of UFOs. Of these, 222 were unexplained, and the explainaiton given for these are insufficient evedence. This means that the Ministry of Defence couldn't find an explanation with the information given to them - insufficient or not.

A further I69 reports were labelled Miscellaneous - and the rest were either Sattelites and debri; Balloons; Celestial objects; Aircraft; Meteorological and natural phenomena; while the miscellaneous were either hoaxes; reflections of lights on clouds; flares; fireworks;kites; lights on tail structures; photographic abberations and Bird flocks.

We have no comment to make has to the above, except to say that the general public do not normally make reports direct to the M.of. D. the report is first given to an official body (police, etc-) who determine the amount of evedence required to enable them to make the said report. If such official bodies cannot determine what constitutes sufficient evedence for a UFO, then it is no wonder the general public are prepared to make up their own minds.

The following RUMANIAN sighting was kindly sent to us by the President of CONTACT INTERNATIONAL, John. Bowman. Longhorn. Mr Longhorn has very kindly shown great interest in the suggestion that both our respective bodies, CONTACT and UFO INFO, should work together in the pursuit of UFO research. The report is from an CONTACT INTERNATIONAL member.

A LUMINOUS OBJECT PHOTOGRAPHED OVER VALENII DE MUNTE

Following is the narrative of Mr Calin Turcu, schoolteacher from Valenii De Munte, (Progresuli Street, No 56), Prahava, Rumania, Concerning his observation of an UFO on December 11th, 1974, more or less in his own words:

" On the evening of Wednesday, the 11th Dec, 1974, I was type a material in my private room. This work lasted more a usual till after midnight. At one time I heard my dog barking in the back court of the house. I went out of the house and at first I don't observe nothing strange. I untied the dog, but I don't remember which way he go, or if he bark on. I turned to home, when I observe my shadow was intensely casted and very well outlined of a strong light on the white wall. I turned to the hills situated beyond the Teleojen river at approximately one kilometer distance, I saw at the time a dazzling white light, like the light of a soldering apperatus. It was much brighter and had no definite outline. It was hard to look at it indirectly.

The light was pulsating rhythmically and was lighting very well the surroundings. I went into the house and took up the camera and I went out of the house, (I looked at the watch: It was twenty two past one).

The light was in slow vertical motion, ascending 10-12 seconds, descending 10-12 seconds. At the time when the brightness when was maximum in the sky, The hills and woods was lighting on several kilometers. When the brightness was minimum, the light seemed like a head-light at a distance. The period between two pulsations was 2 seconds.

The light distinguished slow after the last ascension which was more long than those anterior. No sound was heard during the whole sighting, which lasted 12 minutes, until 1.34. AM. The luminous object don't reappear. There were no physical effects to the witnesses other than the normal trauma in such cases..

Apparent size - 6CM and one kilometer away. Elevation angle between 32-35 degrees Astronomic Azimuth with the origin in the South Direction + 240 degrees.

Nobody from my family or friends don't know about this event than very late. After development of the film, was found emptyness of frames. Each negative frame presented a small black point of various forms.

One month later I informed about my observation and publicist from Rumania, because he has a large experience with the ' flying saucers ', and he knew many cases from the world over. I mention that I was well known by the writer ION HOBANA ('UFOs FROM BEHIND THE IRON CURTAIN; Corgi paperback, 1975), because in the autumn of 1972 I have informed him about a UFO landing from the VALEA PLOPUI village and where I participated investigations.

Mr ION HOBANA was surprised of my photos which resemble the following cases:

- 1/ SAUTERRAIN (CREUSE) France, Sept 2-3, 1968.
- 2/ PAYMONVILLE (LIEGE) July 19th 1972.
- 3/ OKINAWA (JAPAN) Sept 22nd 1972.
- 4/ NAGAI (JAPAN) July 9th 1973.

Soon after that the negative was examined Photogrammetry and tele-detection-wise, at laboratory from BUCHAREST by two engineers, Dan Raduascu and Dan Mihailescu. The conclusion was the following:

- I/ The images of the object are photographic images and don't result from defection in the film.

- 2/ The images are not parestite images which accidentally penetrated into the cassette.
 - 3/ The film registered the real light source.
 - 4/ The photographic images are very small: follow that the object was small or far off with brilliant radiation.
 - 5/ Through the comparing of the maximum dimension of the images was established the object executed motions on the direction of observation . It was approaching and retiring from observer creating the illusion of vertical motion. Calin Turcu cannot agree there. He don't observe an approaching and a retiring of the flight.
 - 6/ Studying the position of the longitudinal axis of the images in comparrison with the frame of the film was established the object had a rotary motion in plane.
 - 7/ It cannot be excluded a false created manipulation of intense light bright source, but the presence of the halo from the first photo can decline a dodge.

Mr Calin Turcu was using a Beirette Camera made in Germany, a Meritar 2;9 / 45. The film was LEIKE black and white ORWO 20 dim (80 ASA) made in GDR. It wasn't used with tripod or solid stand.
