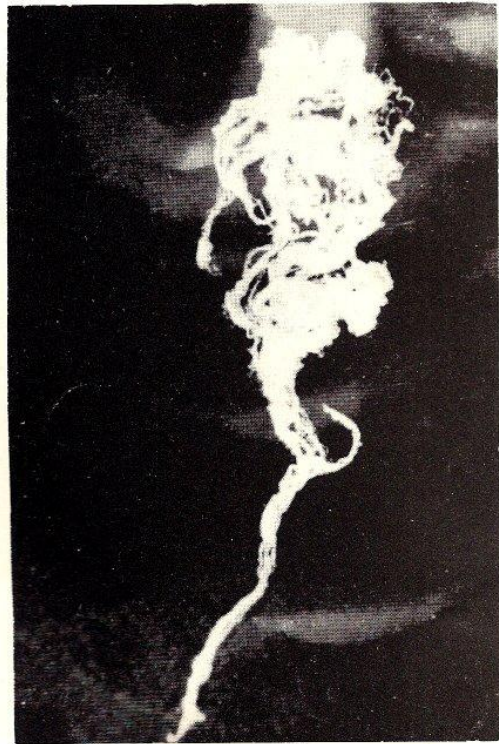
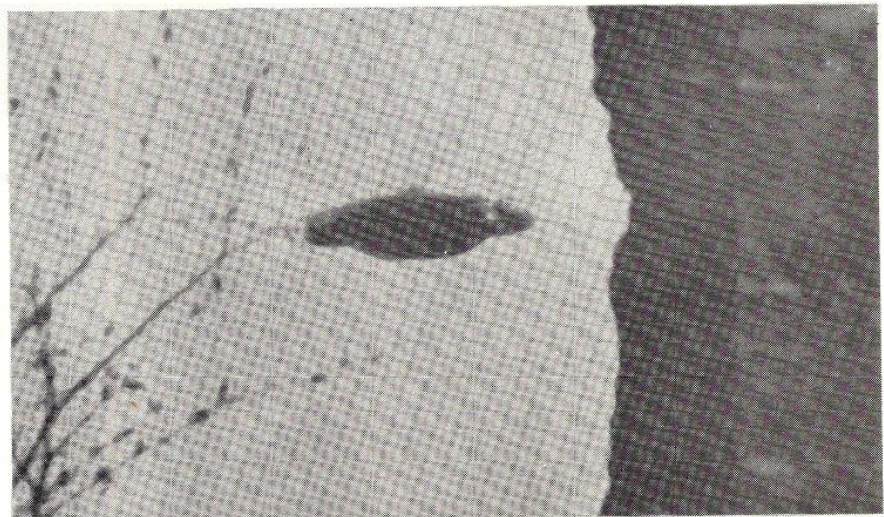


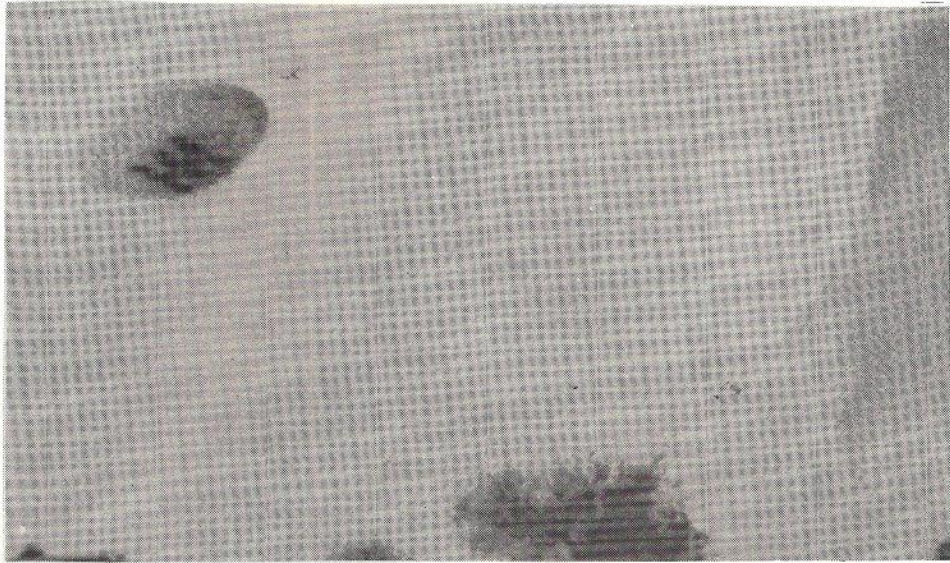
"Angel-Hair" photographed over Ichinoseki, Japan. A substance which sometimes falls during a UFO sighting. It dissolves almost instantly.



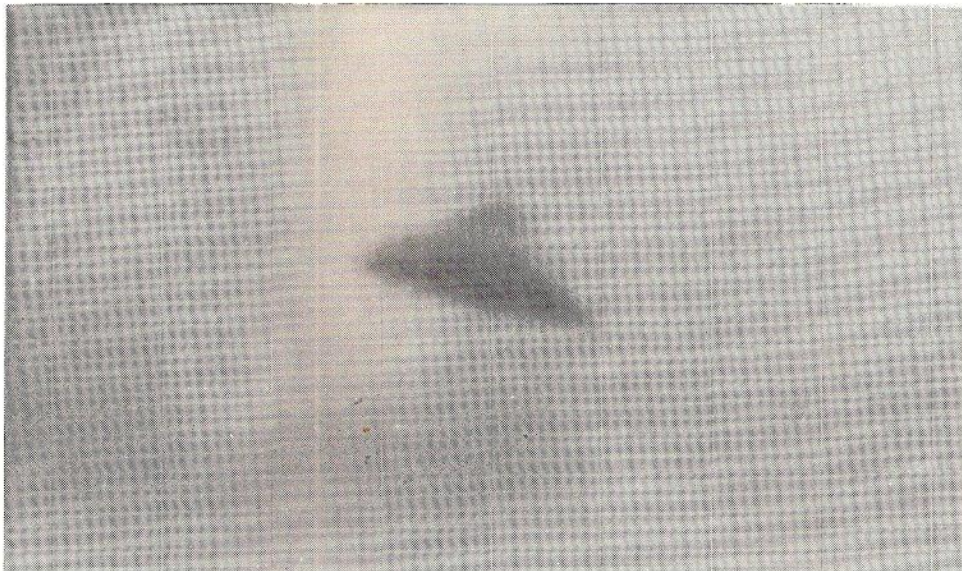
← UFO photographed over Kaizuka, Japan in 1958.

'Amber Gambler' Mystery: Solved?

On the photograph pages, you will see a shot that was taken in Warminster in 1976 by Mr. Ian Mazyglod of Bristol, who is a member of our team. The remarkable thing about this picture is that when it was taken, the object that appears in the picture was not seen by the cameraman or by any of the people with him.

The questions that this picture raises are many, the theories put forward for it are also plentiful. In the next couple of pages you will see a possible solution to this picture, which could possibly solve many mysteries. I don't believe the object to be a FLYING SAUCER, but certainly a UFO; one worthy of more scientific investigation.

UFO's and Flying Saucers are fact, and it is time that Governments realised that their excuses are falling on deaf ears. I believe that what has been photographed could possibly be a new energy source that could be harnessed, and the remarkable element involved is that Ley Lines also come into this.

Many people believe that UFO's and Ley Lines are connected, the reason being the formation by Leys of a energy-grid which spans the globe. This network has cross-points, and I believe "energy values" where surplus energy may be released. Warminster is one of these "cross-points"; Stonehenge is another. (This could well be a reason why Stonehenge has now been closed off to the public). The object in the photograph may well be the energy itself, being released.

Below I will try and explain, in a not very scientific way, what we believe we have discovered.

Formation of the Ball Energy

In certain areas in the UK (as I have pointed out already) the Earth's crust acts as a kind of energy valve in the same way lightning discharges itself upwards. I will describe here an eye-witness account of the forming of one of these balls. You must realise that the person was describing what he thought was a flying saucer taking energy from the Earth.

"I was standing on the hill when I observed a candle-light effect on the ground, this light then merged into a beam which beamed upwards. On looking up I saw an amber ball which hovered for a few minutes then shot off at fantastic speed and disappeared".

The person who described the above was convinced he had seen a flying saucer, I am not so sure now. On examination of his story I tend to believe what actually happened was: the candle-light effect was coming from the ground and when it reached a certain density it fused into a mass, which was drawn into the sky by either the Earth's magnetic field or a possible positive/negative reaction in the upper atmosphere.

When it reached the atmosphere it started to be fused into a single mass of energy. As the energy was drawn up it started the ball spinning at an extremely high speed, this then causes a further chain reaction within the mass causing it to move, the spin increased and so increasing the speed at which it travels. This happens very quickly and soon the object is moving across the sky at a very high speed.

### Proof of the Speeds

We believe that this object travels at these speeds because recently my assistant editor was testing his camera at night by photographing a satellite, when the film was developed we found one of these balls of energy on the film. But at no time did the photographer or any of the people with him witness the object in the sky.

### Summary

#### Point 1.

If the object is mass which we believe it to be, it would displace air in the atmosphere. At the speeds it travels it would cause a sub-sonic boom similar to the one attributed to Concorde. This would explain the booms heard when Concorde was not in flight, and also the booms recorded in Historic records.

#### Point 2.

Under proper scientific study, we believe it may be possible to tap this natural energy instead of letting it go to waste in the atmosphere. We would recommend a close look at the works of Nichola Tesla, the scientist who used to work on electro-magnetic energy, also a very close study of the ancient ley system as this we believe may point to the locations of these energy valves on the Earth's surface.

#### Point 3.

The Tunguska Forest Explosion could well have been caused by one of these high energy balls, that did not peter out, but continued to grow eventually causing a massive explosion.

#### Point 4.

Unexplainable plane crashes, this we would tend to think could be caused by one of these energy balls travelling at the speed of light and coming in direct contact with an aircraft en route. The flight box recorder would not record any malfunction of the od the aircraft. Try to imagine the consequences of a mass of energy travelling at the speed of light hitting an aircraft, there would be be a massive explosion. No recording of fault and you would be left with a mystery plane crash.

#### Point 5.

Countless supposed UFO photographs, of which we have over 50 of what we think is the same object in various forms of its creation.

I apologise for the poor grammar in which this article is written, also the very unscientific, just ordinary people tryint to solve a mystery. We are giving you, the scientists, as much information as possible, we have slides to support the existence of this object, and we think we may be able to help in locations of the valve exits.

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Conference May 1978

## UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

The information contained here has been compiled to respond to queries on Unidentified Flying Objects directed to the White House as well as NASA.

NASA is the focal point for answering public inquiries to the White House relating to UFOs. NASA is not engaged in a research program involving these phenomena, nor is any other government agency.

## BACKGROUND

In July of 1977, Dr. Frank Press, Director of Science and Technology Policy, Executive Office of the President, wrote to Dr. Robert A. Frosch, the NASA Administrator, suggesting NASA should answer all UFO-related mail and also to consider whether NASA should conduct an active research program on UFOs. In a letter dated December 21, 1977, Dr. Frosch agreed that NASA will continue to respond to UFO-related mail as it has in the past and, if a new element of hard evidence that UFOs exist is brought to NASA's attention from a credible source, NASA will analyze the unexplained organic or inorganic sample and report its findings.

Quoting from Dr. Frosch's December 21 letter: "...If some new element of hard evidence is brought to our attention in the future, it would be entirely appropriate for a NASA laboratory to analyze and report upon an otherwise unexplained organic or inorganic sample; we stand ready to respond to any bona fide physical evidence from credible sources. We intend to leave the door clearly open for such a possibility.

"We have given considerable thought to the question of what else the United States might and should do in the area of UFO research. There is an absence of tangible or physical evidence available for thorough laboratory analysis. And, because of the absence of such evidence, we have not been able to devise a sound scientific procedure for investigating these phenomena. To proceed on a research task without a sound disciplinary framework and an exploratory technique in mind would be wasteful and probably unproductive.

"I do not feel that we could mount a research effort without a better starting point than we have been able to identify thus far. I would therefore propose that NASA take no steps to establish research in this area or to convene a symposium on this subject.

"I wish in no way to indicate that NASA has come to any conclusion about these phenomena as such; institutionally, we retain an open mind, a keen sense of scientific curiosity and a willingness to analyze technical problems within our competence."

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Reports of unidentified objects entering United States air space are of interest to the military as a regular part of defense surveillance. Beyond that, the U. S. Air Force no longer investigates reports of UFO sightings.

This was not always the case. On December 17, 1969, the Secretary of the Air Force announced the termination of Project Blue Book, the Air Force program for UFO investigation started in 1947.

The decision to discontinue UFO investigations, the USAF said, was based on: (1) an evaluation of a report (often called the Condon Report) prepared by the University of Colorado and entitled "Scientific Study of Unidentified Flying Objects;" (2) a review of the University of Colorado report by the National Academy of Sciences; (3) past UFO studies; and (4) Air Force experience investigating UFO reports for two decades.

As a result of these investigations and studies, and experience gained from investigating UFO reports since 1948, the conclusions of the Air Force were: (1) no UFO reported, investigated, and evaluated by the Air Force has ever given any indication of threat to our national security; (2) there has been no evidence submitted to or discovered by the Air Force that sightings categorized as "unidentified" represent technological developments or principles beyond the range of present day scientific knowledge; and (3) there has been no evidence indicating that sightings categorized as "unidentified" are extraterrestrial vehicles.

With the termination of Project Blue Book, the Air Force regulation establishing and controlling the program for investigating and analyzing UFOs was rescinded. All documentation regarding the former Blue Book investigation has been permanently transferred to the Modern Military Branch, National Archives and Records Service, 8th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20408, and is available for public review and analysis. Those wishing to review this material may obtain a

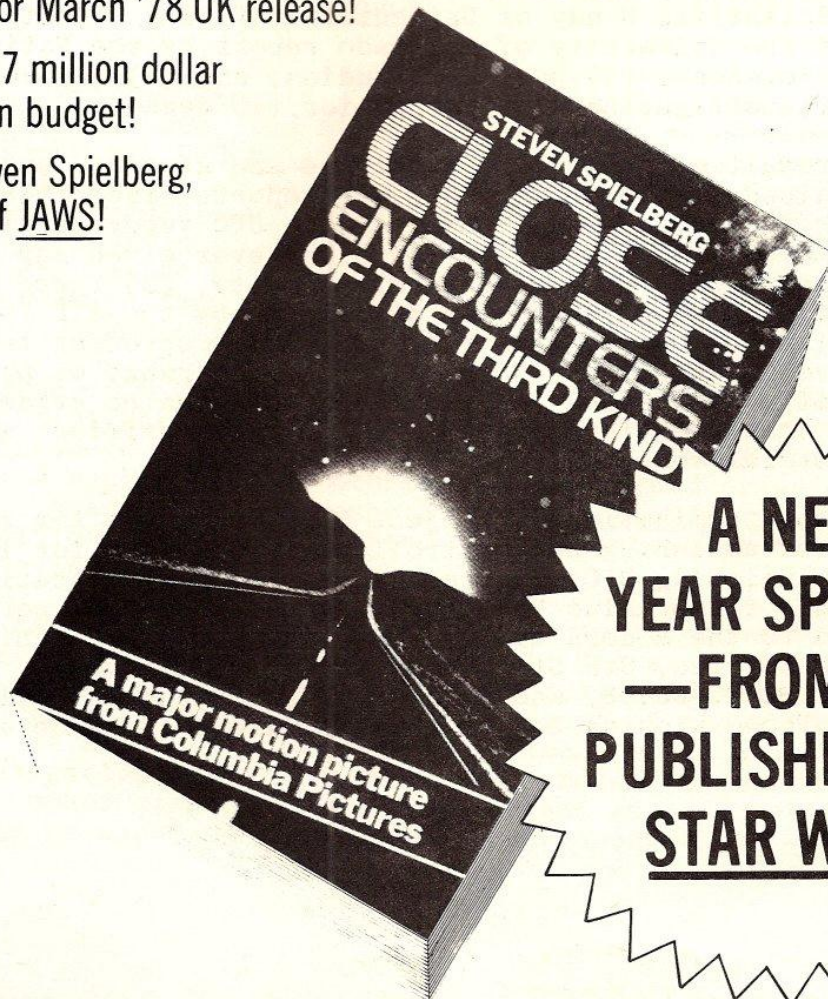
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
